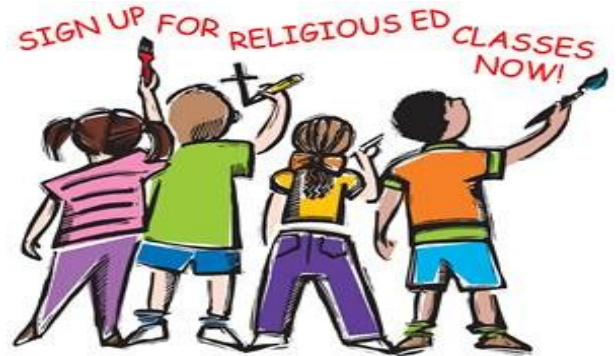

PLEASE SIGN UP TO HELP WITH FAMILY PROMISE Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church is hosting guests the week of September 7th through the 14th. For those who are not familiar with Family Promise it is an organization that works with families who would otherwise be homeless. Serviced by a network of churches to which we belong, the network provides an evening meal, a place to sleep and a quick breakfast. During the day, they are at the center for Family Promise. While the children are in school or day care the adults either go to work, look for a job and learn new skills that will help them in the future. In order to accomplish this ministry, help is needed to care for them while they are here at OLPH. Needed are two people to fix evening meals, two evening hosts, and two overnight hosts for each day. Please see the sign up board in the Commons to see how you might be able to help. Thank you for your continuing help with this ministry. We couldn't do it without you.
