Blessing of the Animals is **Saturday, October 4th at 9:30 am at the Picnic Pavilion.**

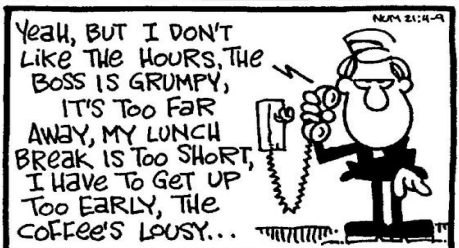
