## THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

**OUR PARISH** will be taking up a Collection for the **Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS)** this weekend, a collection approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years. The AMS provides pastoral care to Catholic men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or who work for the federal government beyond U.S. borders - including those from our own parish and diocese. **The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military, and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment. **FAMILY PROMISE** is a program that we support as a parish by housing families overnight in our Family Life Center three or four times a year, who are homeless and are trying to get their lives back together. **What is needed from you is support.** 1. *Fixing and serving a meal, (from 5:30 - 7:00 pm).* 2. *Being an evening host (spending two hours in our Family Life Center and being present to the families and children who will be staying with us (from 7:00 - 9:00 pm).* 3. *Being an overnight host by spending the night (cots are provided from 9:00 pm - 7:00 am.).*

Also needed are two teams of four people to set up on the Sunday they arrive ( December 7th) usually after Mass on Sunday at 12:00 pm and to break down on Sunday mornings the day they leave ( December 14th at 7:00 am). This is so that our Sunday activities, Religious Education Classes can take place beginning at 8:30 am.
