Let Us Pray

Invite the children to gather in the prayer space and make the Sign of the Cross. Read aloud the leader's prayer. Proclaim the Psalm verse together. Discuss its meaning with the children. Have the children move out of the prayer space and back to their seats.

Let Us Pray

Together, make the Sign of the Cross. Read aloud the leader's prayer and Psalm verse. Prompt the response.

► Music Option: While the children are gathered in the prayer space, play "God Is Our Father," downloaded from **aliveinchrist.osv.com**.

Have the children move out of the prayer space and back to their seats.

Say: Everyone wants to be happy. But our longing for happiness cannot be satisfied by things, only by God. God wants us to be happy with him forever. In this reading, we see just how much we long for God.


