Mix them up and encourage your child to put the words in correct order <u>several</u> times. Play a "review game" by <u>removing</u> some words and allowing your child to put the words back in the correct places. Repeat as often as necessary until your child is comfortable with the first few phrases of this prayer.

His only Son, our Lord,

who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,

born of the Virgin Mary,

suffered under Pontius Pilate,

was crucified, died, and was buried.

Print and cut out the word "cards" that are associated with these phrases and play "games" until your child is comfortable with these phrases.

Then work with these phrases:

He descended into Hell.

On the third day, He arose from the dead.

He ascended into Heaven

and sits at the right hand of God,

the Father Almighty;

from thence He shall come to judge

the living and the dead.

Print and cut out the word "cards" that are associated with these phrases and play "games" until your child is comfortable with these phrases.

Then work with these phrases:

the Holy Catholic Church,

the Communion of Saints,

the forgiveness of sins,

the Resurrection of the body,

and life everlasting.
