THE PILGRIMAGE

The pilgrimage begins **Sunday, May 16** with a Mass at the Our Lady of Fatima Shrine in Russells Point in the Northern area of the Archdiocese. From there, small groups of pilgrims will begin this historic pilgrimage with a special statue of Our Lady of Fatima, blessed by Archbishop Schnurr for this occasion.

The pilgrimage will last for 33 days, making stops at parishes in every deanery of the Archdiocese, and will be highlighted by four cornerstone family events.

The pilgrimage will end at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains on the day of the bicentennial, Saturday, June 19. On that day, the Archbishop will re-consecrate the Archdiocese to Jesus through Mary during a special Mass commemorating the bicentennial.

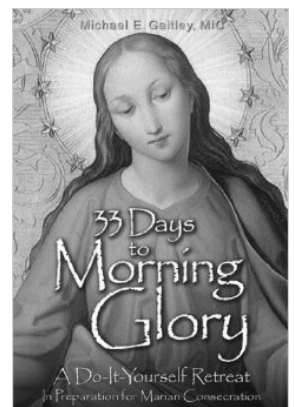
The Four Cornerstone Events

- Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, Russells Point, **May 16**
- Mass and a concert by Sarah Kroger at Maria Stein, **May 21**
- Mass and a concert by WAL at Chaminade-Julienne High School, Dayton, **May 29**
- Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Peter in Chains, Cincinnati and Concert by Village Lights at Fountain Square, Cincinnati, **June 19**
