COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

The Catholic Daughters and our Council will sponsor the Public Square Rosary on Saturday, October 12, on the KC grounds under the oak trees. Bring your rosary, lawn chairs, water and umbrella. Invite your family, friends and the public.

Each year, U. S. Catholics observe the month of October as Respect Life Month. One way we observe this month in our cluster is by participating in 40 Days for Life, an annual event highlighted in the recent movie, Unplanned. **We ask for volunteers each year to pray peacefully outside an abortion clinic in Baton Rouge, committing to one hour during the day. This year's date for our cluster is Monday, October 7 (the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary).** Volunteers will pray outside Delta Clinic of Baton Rouge, located at 756 Colonial Drive.
