

## CHOOSING A CONFIRMATION SPONSOR

The church recognizes a sponsor as a person who is willing to actively engage in the confirmation process with the candidate, who has a comfortable relationship with the candidate, and who has a long term interest in helping the candidate fulfill his/her baptismal promises.

Since our program calls for active participation, the Confirmation sponsor is also ideally someone who can spend time with the candidate during this time and after the reception of the sacrament.

Please use these guidelines when discussing your child's choice of a Confirmation sponsor.

- The sponsor must be Catholic, 18 years or older, and has received the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation.
- The sponsor must not be the candidate's parent.
- The sponsor must be available for active involvement in the process. Location and commitment is a factor.
- The sponsor must be a good model for living the life of a faithful Catholic who is continually nourishing his/her own faith through active participation.
- Consider their Godparent. The sponsor has similar responsibilities in Baptism and Confirmation.
- The sponsor must be able to attend "**Rite of Welcoming**" on **September 14/15, 2019** with candidate at one of the following masses: 6:00 pm at St. Michael; 9:00 am at St. Joseph; or 5:00 pm at Sacred Heart.
- The sponsor must attend the Confirmation Session with the candidate **on Sunday, October 27, 2019** at 6:15 pm at Sacred Heart Church
- The sponsor must attend practice on **February 15, 2020** at 5:15 pm for St. Joseph (for those making Confirmation on February 17<sup>th</sup> at St. Joseph) or at 7:15 pm at St. Michael (for those making Confirmation on February 18<sup>th</sup> at St. Michael).
- The sponsor must present the candidate to the Bishop at the **Confirmation ceremony, on February 17, 2020 at St. Joseph or February 18, 2019 at St. Michael. The ceremonies begin at 6:30 pm.**

### Some Suggestions for Sponsors

Attend Sunday Mass together.

Participate with the candidate during service involvement.

Participate in the sacrament of Reconciliation together.

Talk with the candidate about your own Confirmation and the importance of faith in your life. Find out what faith means in the candidate's life now.

We will be praying for you while you are making this important decision.

Sponsor Forms must be turned in **by September 8/9** in order to participate in the Rite of Welcoming.

## CONFIRMATION SPONSOR FORM

To be selected as a sponsor for Confirmation is a great privilege and responsibility. Being a sponsor is not just an honor given to a good friend or relative. Sponsorship calls for the ability and desire to "share" what it means to live as a **Catholic**, living a life in good standing with the Church. We ask you to take this responsibility seriously.

\_\_\_ I will attend **practice** on **February 15** at 5:15 pm at St. Joseph for those making Confirmation on February 17<sup>th</sup> or at 7:15 pm at St. Michael for those making Confirmation on February 18<sup>th</sup>.

\_\_\_ I will present the candidate to the Bishop at the **Confirmation ceremony, on February 17 at St. Joseph or February 18 at St. Michael. The ceremonies begin at 6:30 pm.**

I understand the responsibilities I am undertaking and I have both the desire and intention to fulfill them. I am in good standing with the Catholic Church, attend mass every Sunday, if married it is within the church, and I model solid Catholic Christian behavior.
