

Dress Code:

It is the obligation of our church parishes to provide a proper educational and religious atmosphere which shall be conducive to the learning process as well as spiritual growth and morality. Students, teachers, and staff have the right to be free from distractions which hinder the learning process and go against the moral code. No mode of attire will be considered proper for school wear that distracts from or disrupts classroom learning. The DRE makes the final decision as to what is considered proper or improper dress according to the guidelines provided. The parish staff believes it is the responsibility of each student/parent to use good judgment in one's appearance so that the attention of others is not distracted from the purpose of their school.

	Allowed	Not Allowed
Boys	School approved uniform shirt or a shirt with sleeves. Pants or shorts not more than 3 inches above the knee.	Sleeveless or cut- off shirts are NOT allowed. Shirts containing inappropriate words or graphics are NOT allowed.
Girls	School approved uniform shirt or a shirt with sleeves. Pants/shorts/skirts/ dresses not more than 3 inches above the knee.	Sleeveless, backless, strapless, low cut, or crop tops are NOT allowed. Shirts containing inappropriate words or graphics are NOT allowed.
Shoes	Sandals must have a strap in the back. Tennis shoes are allowed.	Flip flops, Crocs, Slippers
Hats	None	Please do not wear hats. Hats are not allowed in church. If hats are worn, they will be kept in the office until dismissal.

Dress Code Offense:

1st offense: warning/reminder (phone call home)

2nd offense: parent will be called to bring a change of clothes

Students will be going into the church, so they need to be dressed appropriately and respectfully. Please do not send children to class with unnecessary items that may cause a distraction such as sun glasses, purses, cell phones, hats, rubber bands, etc. Water bottles are allowed as long as they do not cause a disturbance.
