CHOOSING A CONFIRMATION SPONSOR

The church recognizes a sponsor as a person who is willing to actively engage in the confirmation process with the candidate, who has a comfortable relationship with the candidate, and who has a long term interest in helping the candidate fulfill his/her baptismal promises.

Since our program calls for active participation, the Confirmation sponsor is also ideally someone who can spend time with the candidate during this time and after the reception of the sacrament.

Please use these guidelines when discussing your child's choice of a Confirmation sponsor.

- The sponsor must be Catholic, 18 years or older, and has received the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation.
- The sponsor must not be the candidate's parent.
- The sponsor must be available for active involvement in the process. Location and commitment is a factor.
- The sponsor must be a good model for living the life of a faithful Catholic who is continually nourishing his/her own faith through active participation.
- Consider their Godparent. The sponsor has similar responsibilities in Baptism and Confirmation.
- The sponsor must be able to attend "**Rite of Welcoming**" on **September 7, 2025** with candidate at one of the following masses: 8:00 am at St. Michael; 10:00 am at St. Joseph; or 5:00 pm at Sacred Heart.
- The sponsor meet with and work with the student to complete the Student/Sponsor Packets given out at class on November 2/3 and return completed packet in at class on **November 16/17, 2025**.
- The sponsor must attend practice on **January 25** at 11:30 am at St. Joseph.
- The sponsor must present the candidate to the Bishop at the Confirmation ceremony, on January 27, 2026 at St. Joseph at 6:00 pm Mass.

Some Suggestions for Sponsors

Attend Sunday Mass together.

Participate with the candidate during service involvement.

Participate in the sacrament of Reconciliation together.

Talk with the candidate about your own Confirmation and the importance of faith in your life. Find out what faith means in the candidate's life now.

We will be praying for you while you are making this important decision.

Sponsor Forms must be turned in **by August 24/25, 2025** in order to participate in the Rite of Welcoming.
