READING

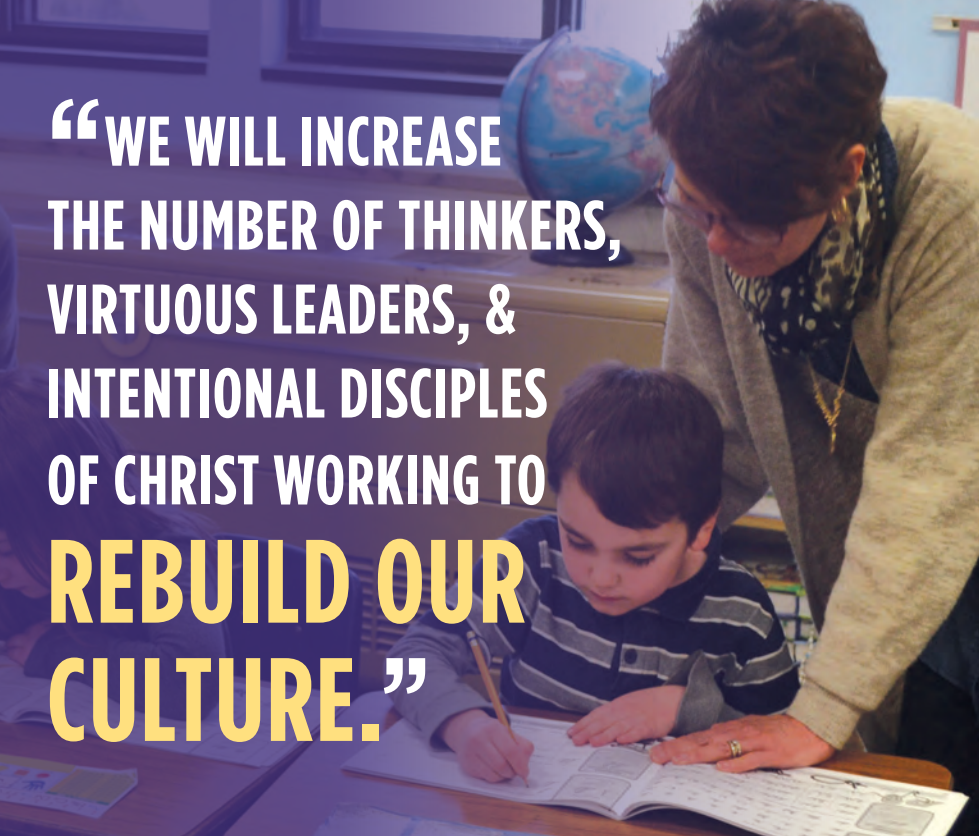

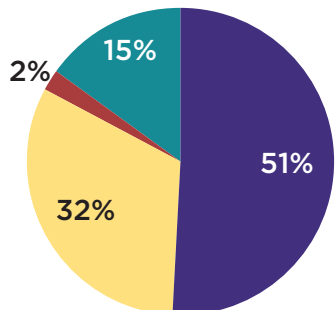

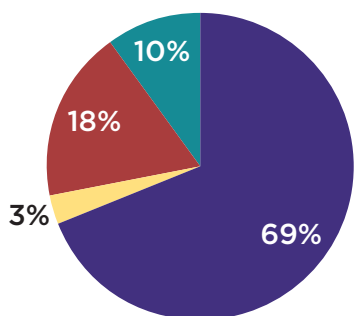
REVENUE

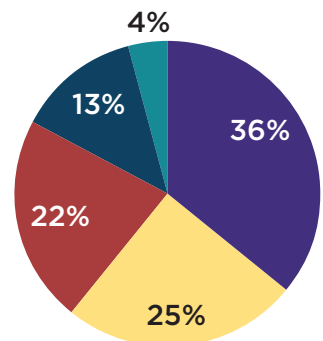
