

From the Desk of Archbishop Jackels to the Priests of the Archdiocese of Dubuque

On Monday, May 18 the bishops of Iowa had a conversation about the issue of re-opening, mostly to clarify what we agreed on. Here is a summary of my understanding:

- 1) We agreed to not reopen when the governor decreed that Churches were free to gather again.
- 2) While recognizing the importance of gathering together for service to the poor, for learning and teaching the Gospel, and for prayer and worship, we agreed to prioritize the health and safety of the population.
- 3) We agreed to be data-driven in deciding when to re-open, namely, a 14-day downward trend in the numbers of new COVID-19 cases, hospitalizations, and deaths. Likewise, after re-opening, a 14-day upward tick in those same numbers would trigger another shutdown (not just a spike, and not just in one place).

Here, in the Archdiocese of Dubuque, we are relying on a detailed review of the relevant data from state and local public health officials for the 30 northeastern counties in lowa.

All that said, there is not yet an indication of when re-opening might occur; I am sorry, so sorry. Not to overstate the obvious, but when we do re-open, we will be asking people to wear a mask, practice social spacing, and help in keeping a clean, hygienic environment.

Also, Catholics in the Archdiocese will remain dispensed from their 2020 Easter Duty, and from the obligation to participate in Mass on Sunday and other holy days until further notice, probably until a vaccine is widely available, or when the Lord works a miracle and the coronavirus disappears.

While we wait for the happy day of re-opening, there are things that parishes can do, if they haven't done them already, for example: close off every other pew in church; mark the pews and aisles to indicate what social spacing looks like; do deep cleaning of buildings; stock up on cleaning and sanitizing supplies.

From the Desk of Fr. Jim Dubert

HAPPY EASTER! For Catholics, our Easter Season continues this year until May 31, 2020, fifty days. As we deal with the COVID-19 crisis our Lenten experience has moved into these last few weeks of the Easter Season. But even with this situation, we can still find "NEW" things to experience the rest of this Easter. As in the last few weeks the new life comes because May is the month of Mary, our blessed Mother! She told us in 1917 at Fatima that the "errors of Russia" will spread, like the COVID-19 virus, across the world. The greatest error is Communism. This virus came because the Chinese Communist Party put its survival over the lives of people throughout the world. This "error" has killed almost one half million people around the world, so far. Only Mary's Immaculate Heart can defeat these errors, according to Fatima. So, Pope Francis, our Holy Father is asking us to seek Mary's Immaculate Heart through rosaries and two new prayers to ask Mary's defeat of the virus. Finally, our new life comes in a renewed appreciation of "Spiritual Communion" when we watch Fr. Paul's live-streamed Mass or other Masses, while we can't have public Masses. Spiritual Communion was the main way most lay Catholics experienced the Eucharist until 1910 when Pope Pius X encouraged "frequent Communion". Spiritual Communion can never be received unworthily, but traditional Eucharist can be if we are not in the "state of grace". St. Paul in First Corinthians 11:27-32 said receiving communion unworthily will result in illness, infirmity, and even death. Doesn't that sound like the COVID-19 disease? But Spiritual Communion only gives us sacramental grace to build up the Body of Christ.

Let's all examine our conscience to see if we are in the state of grace to receive Eucharist worthily when public Masses begin again!






