

St. Boniface Finance Council Meeting

The St. Boniface Finance Council held a bi-annual meeting November 28, 2018 at 6:30 PM in the Spiritual Room, St. Boniface Church.

Present were: Rev. James Dubert, Paul Reding, Scott Bell, Greg Rayhons, Justin Wellik, Excused were Jeanne Zwald.

Fr. Dubert discussed and distributed a copy of the Budget and Balance Sheet. Fr. stated that our church is \$12000. Dollars short for the month. Fr. said he was not concerned because the church has money in the D&L Savings Account to transfer from.

Fr. Dubert informed us that Kaylegh Garcia is resigning from Coordinator of Religious Education/ Youth Ministry on December 7, 2018. Fr. said that Deacon Thomas Blomme agreed to fill in until someone else is hired. Fr. also stated that Regina Adams will be retiring the end of June from Director of Faith Formation.

Our council discussed the kitchen remodel project. There has been a lot of meetings and discussions with the kitchen remodel committee but no definite plans yet. Fr. stated that he will not agree to a new building.

Fr. Dubert said he is putting together our budget for 2019, to be approved at a special meeting.

Paul and Greg reported on an estimate from Roster Tuckpointing, Ottumwa, Ia. The cost to do the exterior columns is \$400. per column. No contract has been signed yet.

Greg reported that North Iowa Custom Seamless Guttering will be replacing the gutters on the Faith Formation building sometime in December at an estimate of \$4383.

Greg asked if someone could do a visual walk through of the church and faith formation building daily. Fr. Dubert suggested Greg should talk to Jackie Young about asking our building opening & closing volunteers.

Our next Finance Council Meeting is scheduled for August 8, 2019. Fr. said the Buildings & Grounds committee can meet anytime needed.

Fr. Dubert led us in closing prayer.
