

SACRED HEART CHOIR [Kindergarten-grade 2] beginning September 5

This choir introduces young singers to proper singing technique, to the joys of group singing, to basic music theory concepts and lays the foundation for dedicated parish ministry. The choir sings once a month at the 11:00 Mass, generally with one or more older choirs.

SAINT CECILIA CHOIR [girls, grades 3-8] beginning September 5

The girls in this choir refine their singing technique, using repertoire spanning the centuries from Gregorian chant through music newly-composed for them. The choir sings twice a month at the 11:00 Mass, usually with the Saint Gregory Choir, and for special liturgies, like First Communion.

SAINT GREGORY CHOIR [boys, grades 3-8, unchanged voices] beg Sep 5

Following in a long tradition of boys' choirs in the Church, these young singers work on developing good vocal technique. Repertoire includes chant and traditional boys' music, as well as music of modern composers. The choir sings twice a month at the 11:00 Mass, usually with the Saint Gregory Choir, and for special liturgies, like First Communion.

SAINT DOMINIC SAVIO CHOIR [boys, changing voices] *beginning Sept 5*
 Named for Saint Dominic Savio, a student of Saint John Bosco and the Patron Saint of choir boys, this group offers boys in grade 8 or younger to continue to sing choral music as their voices change and mature. Particular care is given to choosing music that fits the narrow and lowering range of the *cambiata* (“changing”) singer. The group sings with the Saint Gregory Choir, and occasionally with Archangelus Chorale, Cappella Musica, or on their own.

ARCHANGELUS CHORALE [high school] *beginning September 5*
 This chorale is made up of a group of dedicated high school singers whose ministry is to provide music for the Wednesday evening Mass (7:00 pm). Their repertoire ranges from unison Latin chants through full mixed-voice motets. The choir also joins the youth choirs or the adult choirs for special liturgies.

CAPPELLA MUSICA [adult & high school gr.11-12] *beginning September 6*
 The *Cappella Musica* is the primary adult choir in the parish. They sing a variety of music, including Gregorian chant, Renaissance polyphony, Baroque and Classical chorales, Romantic era motets and music of today. The choir sings twice a month at 11:00 Mass and at the primary liturgies of the liturgical year, including Holy Week.

SCHOLA CANTORUM [adult ensemble, *auditioned*]
 This select ensemble specializes in Gregorian chant and Renaissance polyphony. The choir sings once a month at 11:00 Mass and for special liturgies throughout the year.

JOSEPH OF ARIMATEA CHOIR [funeral ministry] *beginning September 6*
 This choir helps the congregation to sing at funerals and also presents some appropriate choral literature.

Rehearsals: First Thursday morning of the month, 11:00-12:00; and 30 minutes prior to a funeral



HOLY TRINITY ENSEMBLE [grades 4 - high school]
 This auditioned youth schola provides music for Baptisms at the church and also for specific events, like *Carnevale*, *Olde Time Christmas* (Harpers Ferry), the Saint Lawrence Dinner and staged musicals. Tier I: younger singers / Tier II: experienced singers.

BELLS OF OUR LADY OF MERCY [handbell ringers] *beginning Sept 8*
 This group rings our five-octave set of English handbells and our three-octaves of handchimes at the 5:00 pm (Saturday) Anticipated Mass. Members should have a comfortable knowledge of music reading.

ORGANISTS
 Organists perform a vital role in Roman Catholic Church music, both in accompanying the congregation on antiphons, hymns and responses, and in presenting solo music from the vast repertoire for the instrument. Organists interested in helping at the parish should contact Gary Penkala.



CANTORS
 It is the cantor’s primary role to sing the Responsorial Psalm at Mass, but also to lead the congregation in other responsorial music and to assist, if necessary, with hymns. Singers with a clear voice who wish to serve in this ministry should contact Gary Penkala to set up a meeting.



INSTRUMENTALISTS
 We are always looking for instrumentalists to enhance music at our liturgies. If you play an instrument well, be sure your name is on file with the Music Department – we’ll contact you as needs arise.
