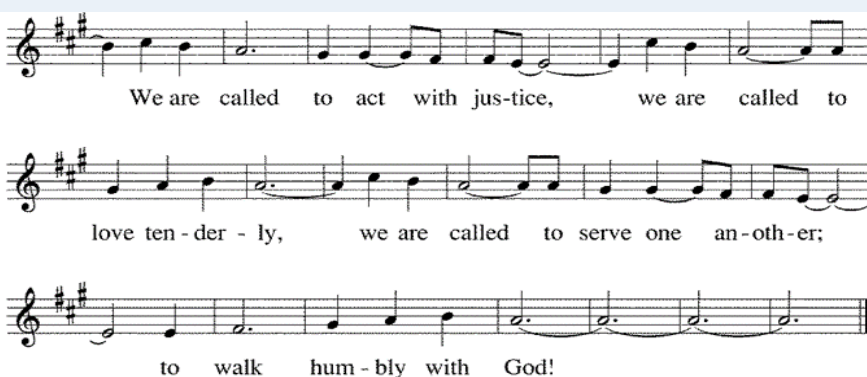

DIRECTION

Isaiah tells us something that we already know, and yet seem to forget every now and then. He tells us, essentially, that God is God and we are not. When we're confused and troubled and can't figure everything out, it might be wise to recall Isaiah speaking on the Lord's behalf and explaining that God—who is on a much more, well, Godly wavelength than we are—moves in ways we can't even imagine.

Saint Paul, by comparison, has everything figured out. Kind of. At least he understands his calling in life—to magnify Christ in everything he does. That should give all of us the direction we need. Jesus gives us direction, too, explaining to us once again in the parable of the workers in the vineyard that the last will be first, and the first, last.

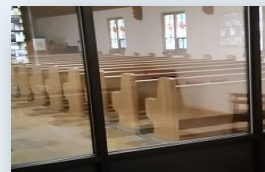

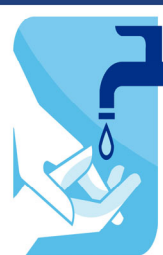

The Campaign for the Precious Ones

The Campaign of the Precious Ones was created to honor the humanity of the unborn child lost through miscarriage, early infant death, and abortion. Through prayer, education, and access to burial these lives will be remembered with dignity and respect. An area of San Lorenzo Cemetery has been designated to:

- 1 - Build a Precious Ones Mausoleum
- 2 - Install a bench for the Mausoleum area
- 3 - Install pavers with baby/family names

We remember these Precious Children and their families in our daily prayer

Precious Ones Mass Cards

- A) Precious Ones Mass Cards can be given to a grieving parent, family, friend who lost a child due to miscarriage, or early infant death. It serves as an invitation to the Precious Ones Mass, which is held in two places in the diocese, usually during the month to remember Holy Souls, in November. The two locations are the Shrine of Our Lady of LaLeche in St. Augustine, FL. In 2020, the Mass will be on 11/15/2020 at 3:00pm. The second Mass is at St. Madeleine Sophie parish in High Springs on 10/25/2020 at 11:30am.
- B) These Precious Ones Mass cards can also be given to those who have gone through a post-abortion healing program such as Project Rachel or Rachel's Vineyard.
- C) Mass Cards are free
- D) The Mass Cards can be obtained from the San Sebastain office or through the Respect Life Coordinator (Lane Campau).
- E) The name of the deceased should be emailed to the Office of Human Life and Dignity (HLD) moliver@dosafi.com and will be recorded in the Book of Innocents and prayed for all year. A votive will be lit on the altar at the Mass for each baby and family listed.
- F) This project helps families in need to bury their babies. It also contributes to the Campaign for the Precious Ones Mausoleum

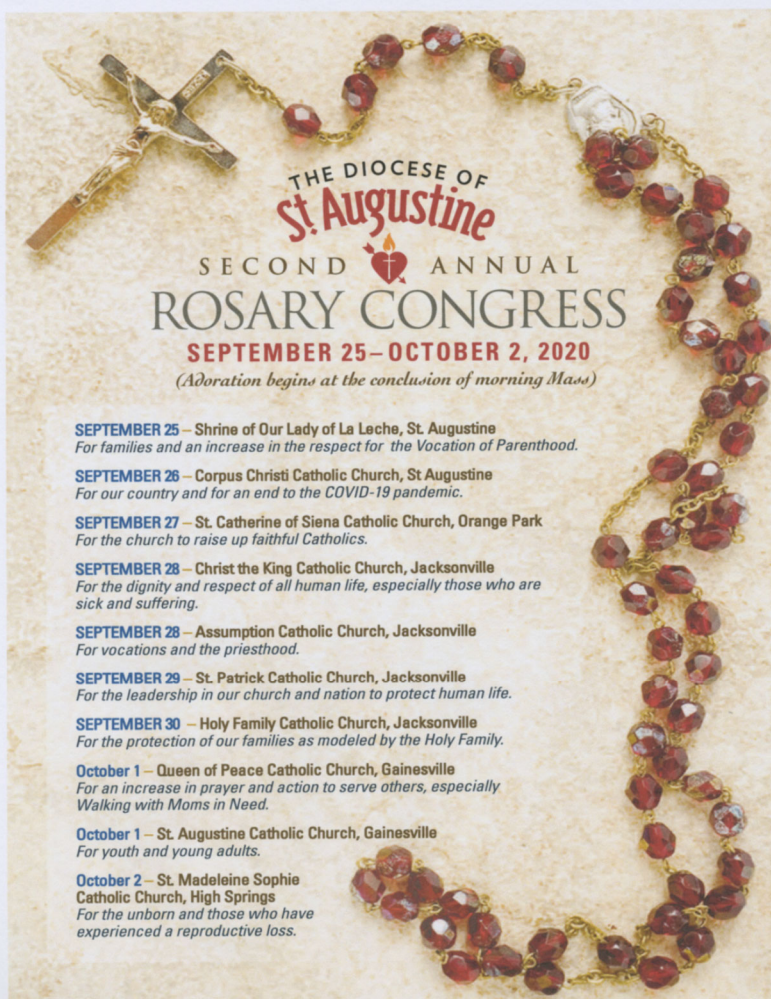
