SAINT OF THE MONTH:

St. Martin De Porres

Feast Day: Nov 3

Born: 1579 :: Died: 1639



Martin was born at Lima in Peru. His father was a Spanish knight and his mother was earlier an Indian slave from Panama who had been set free. When Martin was very young, his father went away, leaving the family to look out for themselves. When he was just ten years old, Martin was placed with a surgeon to learn about the medical field and earn his living. He felt great joy while helping the sick. This kind-hearted saint was also very good to animals. In his sister's house, he kept a home for stray cats and dogs too.
