## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

**Happy Thanksgiving.** From all of us here at St. Pascal Baylon Church and School, we wish you a Happy Thanksgiving this upcoming Thursday. I am thankful for all the ways you participate in our faith community, and I will say a special prayer for you on Thanksgiving Day. If you are available on Thursday morning, **please join us for Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00 AM.**

**Have you ever wondered about the symbols** in the 4-sections of stained glass windows in our church on the left side of the sanctuary near the organ and piano? Here is an explanation of the symbols from a plaque in the Gathering Space that can be found on a section of wall between windows the look into our church from the Gathering Space.

## THE WORKS OF GOD FROM BEFORE TIME TO THE PRESENT MOMENT

These windows read as one window from the top to the bottom.

The top window is of the cosmos...the sun, the moon, stars and comets. At the bottom of this window is the upper curve of the Earth. Note the white line of glass that runs off the top of the window.

The next window contains the bottom curve of the Earth as well as aspects of the cosmos that connect to the story of our redemption. The Star of Bethlehem refers to the Incarnation. The bloodstained wood of the cross and burial linen refer to the Crucifixion of Christ while the morning sunrise speaks visually of Easter.

The next window illustrates how creation participates in the salvation narrative. The sun and rain nourish the land. Grapes and wheat become the stuff of the Eucharist. It is possible to read the three drops of water as a reference to Baptism in the Holy Trinity.

The bottom window, while not specifically referring to the 21<sup>st</sup> century, refers rather to the Eucharistic moment...the "now" of the eating and drinking. Recall the white line of glass referred to in the paragraph about the top window. Notice now that the line continues through the cosmos, through the Earth, through the life of Christ, through the natural world and finally comes to rest as a cruciform in the chalice and host. This, then, is the moment that the Lord has made.

The Ecumenical Thanksgiving Prayer Service has a long tradition here on the East Side of St. Paul, and I am glad that we take this opportunity to pray together.

**Early Learning Scholarships**

The Schulze Family Foundation has created the Schulze Early Learning Scholarship Program to assist middle-income families in gaining access to excellent preschool programs for their children. The application process is now open for the 2019-2020 school year.

### 2013 Friends & Family Fundraising Update

Many have asked about how the 2013 Friends and Family fundraising money was spent. According to Mike Lentz, our previous administrator, your dollars went to the following: Part of that appeal was to improved signage and landscaping at all entryways. \$5,000 went to signage (i.e., corner sign on WB Ave and Conway, lettering on side of building at office entrance and preschool entrance, circle drive, etc.) and almost \$1000 on banners for side of gym and hanging mechanism. The lighted sign at the corner of White Bear and Third was not approved by the City. We spent over \$15,000 on landscaping entryways to parish office and up by chapel and over \$2,000 on relocating the flag and memorial stone to corner by chapel.

Last year's appeal was spent on our PreK playground and has been used every day by our youngest learners. They are able to play in safety with age and size-appropriate equipment thanks to your wonderful generosity. Total cost of the project: \$54,000.00
