FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Fellowship Volunteers Needed for 10:30 AM Mass

We are very short of volunteers at Fellowship following 10:30 AM Sunday Mass to serve donuts, coffee and beverages. We are doing well with volunteers after 8:45 AM Mass. However, we are very short of volunteers for 10:30 AM Mass. There are 9 households with a total of 12 adults who volunteer to serve after 10:30 AM Mass. This ministry needs more volunteers who will regularly sign up to help. Four people are needed every Sunday after 10:30 AM Mass. It only takes about 15 minutes before 10:30 AM Mass to set up and about 60 minutes after 10:30 AM Mass to serve and clean up. Please take a spot in the rotation. This is a nice ministry for grandparents and parents to volunteer with their teens and children. If we have 16 volunteers sign up for serving at Fellowship for 10:30 AM Mass, you would serve once every four weeks. If we have 32 people sign up, you would serve once every 8 weeks, and so forth.

Here is a quick run-down on the specific tasks (training is provided): Come to the kitchen in Brioschi Hall 20 minutes before 10:30 AM Mass. Prepare the coffee, juice and water as needed. Put donuts and cookies on trays. Go to Mass. After Communion, come to Brioschi Hall and fill the coffee carafes. Set out the coffee, donuts, juice and water on the serving tables. Serve, clean up, and go home knowing you are appreciated.

As of right now, we do not have anyone signed up to help with Fellowship after 10:30 AM Mass on June 30. At this point, we might have to cancel Fellowship after 10:30 AM Mass beginning June 30 unless we have enough volunteers sign up to serve.

Lunchroom / Playground Monitor

Work hours are 11:00 AM-12:00 PM, Mon - Fri during school days; \$15 an hour

Responsibilities:

- Monitor the cafeteria, playground, and/or other common areas utilized over the lunch period 11:00 AM-12:00 PM (including classrooms and the gym when utilized for indoor recess)
- Escort students as needed to/from the office, nurse's office, etc.
- Recognize an escalating/emergency situation, call for help, and defuse/assist with the situation until help arrives
- Address and problem solve concerns that are observed or brought forward
- Perform light first aid as needed
- Identify and report students who leave the building without prior authorization
- Assist custodian with limited cleaning functions such as wiping off lunch tables, mopping up spills, picking up trash, etc.
- Other related duties as assigned
