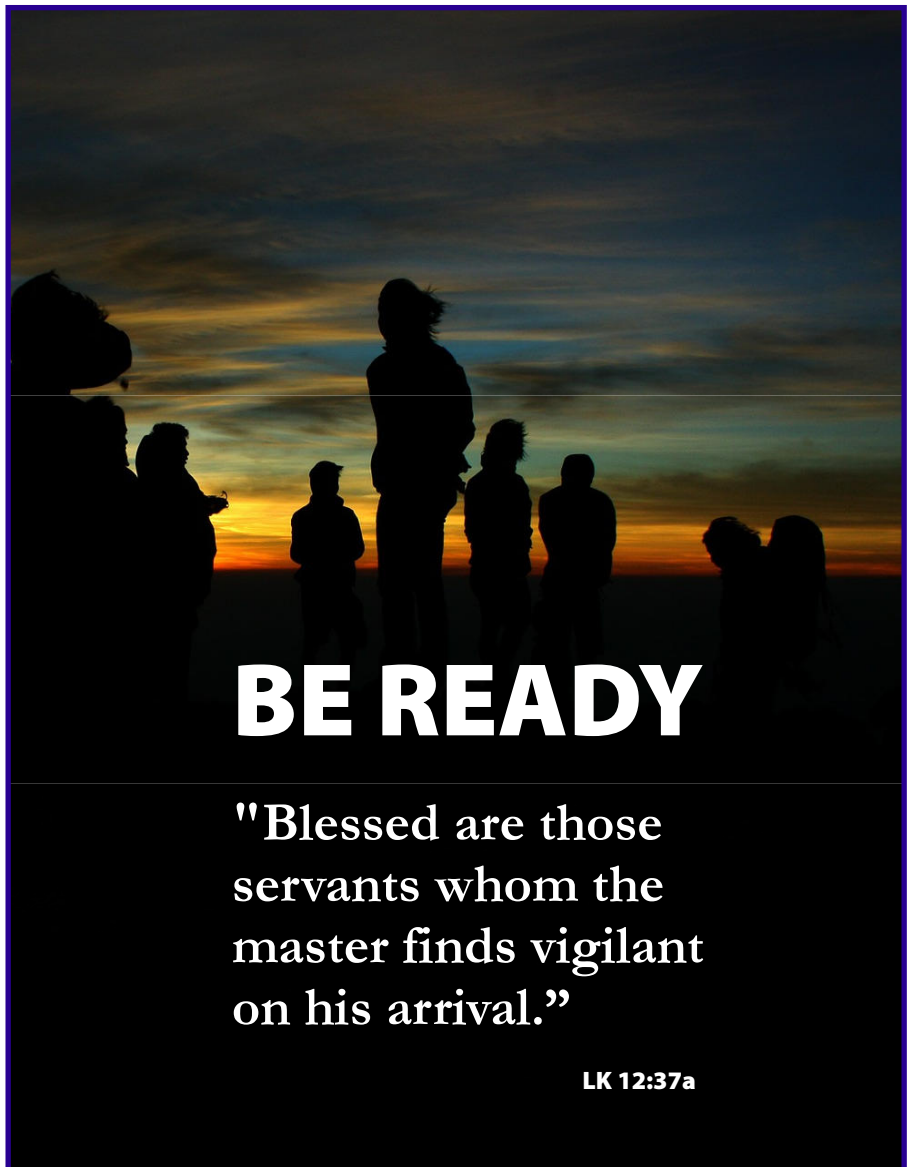

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



### St. Pascal's Fund-A-Need Goal of \$30,000.00 Reached!

Great news! We have reached our \$30,000.00 goal for this year's Fund-A-Need project as part of our annual Friends & Family Event which was held on May 4, 2019. Our Fund-A-Need project this year was installing new computerized controllers for the HVAC units (HVAC: Heating, Ventilation and Air-conditioning) that control the heating and cooling in the Worship Space and Brioschi Hall.

Many thanks to Bill Poppert for his expertise in HVAC systems that enabled us to fine tune our requirements in the bidding process. With Bill's help, we determined that the Worship Space and Brioschi Hall areas are the most critical for upgrading.

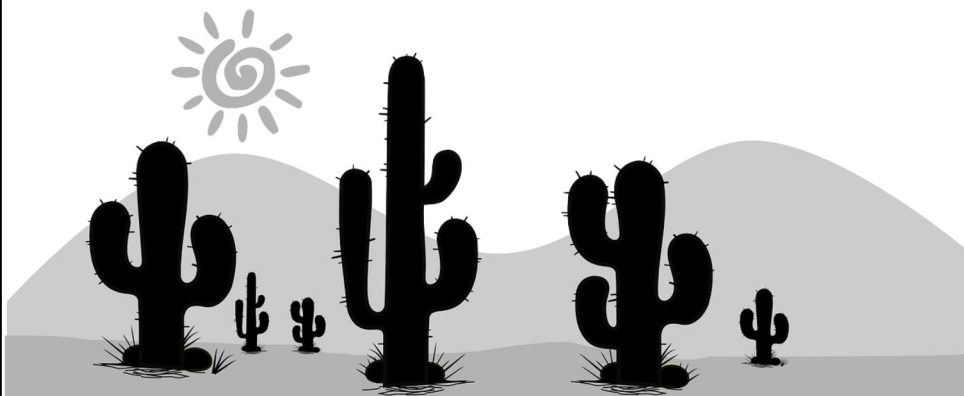
We received three bids for installing new computerized controllers for the air handler units of this HVAC project, and decided to hire Gilbert Mechanical to:

- Install one computerized controller for Brioschi Hall
- Install one computerized controller for the Worship Space (Church)
- Upgrade the timer on the Parish & School Offices

With these new computerized controllers and new timer, we will be able to control the heating and cooling in our building which will result in energy cost savings. Gilbert Mechanical expects to start work on the installation of the controllers and timer within the next few weeks and complete the work by the end of August. Thank you for your generosity in helping us meet our \$30,000.00 Fund-A-Need goal from the 2019 Friends and Family Event. This is a real accomplishment—and blessing—for our parish community!

### Just Faith Groups Starting This Fall

Pope Francis has made it clear that a central theme of his papacy is the demand that we Catholics act to bring about a more just world. Do you hear this message but don't really know where to begin? A JustFaith group will be starting this fall at St. Pascal's to guide participants as they move to put their faith into action.

JustFaith is built around the Social Teachings of the Catholic Church. Small groups meet weekly to discuss selected readings, listen to speakers, watch videos and participate in hands-on experiences. The goal is to deepen your faith, build a sense of community, learn about root causes of social problems and identify ways to respond.
