In response to the Gospel call to serve the poor and spread the Good News, the Catholic Services Appeal Foundation of the Saint Paul and Minneapolis Area (CSAF) works as Christ's hands and feet throughout the 12-county area. An independent non-profit foundation, the CSAF focuses solely on supporting 20 designated outreach ministries. Partnering with these ministries, we help those in need: the hungry, the orphan, the sick, suffering, dying and grieving, the imprisoned, evangelizing Catholic youth and college students, and strengthening families.

The Catholic Services Appeal Foundation offers options for one-time and recurring gift options:

1. **One-time gift.** This is a gift that would be made one time and can be made by cash, credit card or personal check.
2. **Installment gift.** This is a monthly recurring gift. The payment plan would be 10 monthly payments. Reminders are sent monthly.
3. **Credit Card Gifts.** These gifts can be made by credit card as either a one-time gift or a recurring gift.
4. **Automatic Bank Withdrawal Gifts.** These gifts can be automatically deducted monthly from your checking account if you provide the CSAF with a voided check.

Teachers, Staff, and Leadership at St. Pascal Regional Catholic School Join 2,100 Catholic Educators at Summit of Excellence Conference

Catholic grade school faculty and staff convene to enhance excellence in schools through professional development.

The Summit of Excellence on October 16, 2019, was a professional development conference for all Catholic elementary school personnel in the Archdiocese of Minneapolis and St. Paul. All 79 Catholic PreK-8 schools in the 11-county metro area containing over 21,000 students were represented, and more than 2,100 faculty, staff, and leadership were in attendance. This represents almost 100% of school employees.

Areas of learning included:

- Interactive STEM experience about incorporating STEM into the classroom
- Serving exceptional learners (students on both ends of the learning spectrum)
- Addressing student anxiety and depression
- Literacy for all
- Multicultural inclusion

The conference was similar to the Minnesota Educator Academy (MEA) conference for public school teachers.

"Every person in our school contributes to excellence in our school environment and superior education for our students," said Principal Inna Collier Paske. "This is a testament to the commitment of our Catholic school personnel to excellence."

The current journal runs through December. Here is what the Archdiocesan Team for the 2021 Synod writes about the journal:

Thank you for joining with us in prayer during this monumental time for our Archdiocese. We are so grateful for you! During the next two years we will worship and pray together, listen to God together and converse with one another. Our hope for this time is to discern what God desires for the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis. But we also hope that this discernment process will personally draw us more deeply into the love of the Lord and help us to grow in love for one another. To do this we begin with prayer.

This prayer journal is a guide for our journey. It is designed to lead us in discernment for our local Church while also providing an opportunity for each individual to learn and grow. It also will connect us to the greater Catholic Church as the Scripture passages will be largely taken from the daily Mass readings for the liturgical calendar.
