**Year of St. Joseph**

In his October 22 column for The Catholic Spirit, Archbishop Hedda announced that the Archdiocese will be observing a Year of St. Joseph, beginning December 8, 2020 (Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception). Archbishop Hebda wrote, "On that date, the Church Universal will be marking the 150th anniversary of Pope Pius IX's proclamation of St. Joseph as the Patron of the Universal Church. Our hope is that the Year of St. Joseph will be a source of renewal in our local Church, most especially as we continue our preparations for the Synod of 2022."

The lay faithful are invited to join Archbishop Hebda and Bishop Cozzens in preparing for our Archdiocesan Year of St. Joseph, with a 33-day preparation period, beginning November 6.

**Archdiocesan Consecration to St. Joseph**

Archbishop Hebda will consecrate the Archdiocese to Saint Joseph Tuesday, December 8 (Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception), 7 p.m. at the Cathedral of Saint Paul. COVID-19 protocols will be observed for those in attendance, and the event will be livestreamed. ### Financial Statement Update

We now have the capability to send your giving statements via email using a secure server. We will be testing this system in the next few weeks with a year-to-date report. If this goes well, year-end statements will be sent in January via email. Those people who do not have an email address on file will continue to receive their year-end statements in the mail. Hopefully, we will be able to save postage costs in this process.
