## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

**Take nothing for the journey.** Imagine that you were present in the Gospel scene this weekend in Mark 6:7-13. We hear Jesus instruct the Apostles to go on a journey but to take along nothing except a walking stick and sandals—no food, no sack, no money and no extra clothing. It would take a lot of trust to obey those instructions. In our relationship with Jesus, the Lord invites us to trust Him. Trusting God to provide for our needs involves vulnerability where we admit that we are not self-sufficient. I believe God's plans for us are always bigger and better than what we can imagine for ourselves, and so we are invited to trust the God who will lead us day by day and provide for our needs. "Take nothing for the journey" (Mark 6:8) sounds risky, but when we empty our hands, then we have open hands to receive all the blessings that God has planned for us.

## — ARCHDIOCESAN SYNOD 2022 —

### *Seeking Facilitators and Scribes for Parish Small Groups*

This fall our parish, along with all the parishes of the Archdiocese, will be hosting Synod small groups as part of the Parish Consultation Process. The small groups will meet for 6 sessions/weeks on Monday evenings and Tuesday mornings between September 20 and October 27. The Archdiocese will provide the materials which will allow small group members to dig deeper into the focus areas by considering Scripture, Church teaching, and today's cultural context, along with discussion and feedback to the Archdiocese.

We will need facilitators and scribes for each small group. If you are willing and able, or know someone who might be good for this kind of work, please contact Kim Roering in the parish office. The expectations for facilitators and scribes are noted below.

### *Small Group Facilitator and Scribe Expectations*

- **Attend Fall Training:** Attend one training. Trainings will be offered by the Archdiocese late August and early September, 2021, and will cover (i) Synod Small Group material use and reporting feedback, and (ii) facilitator and scribe training.
- **Faithful:** Faithful practicing Catholic who desires to help others grow in their faith through the Synod small group process.
- **Prepare:** Be prepared for the weekly lessons. Arrive on time and welcome members.
- **(Facilitators) Encourage:** Encourage and joyfully support the members as you guide the discussion. Let them know you care about them and value their input. Be a good listener.
- **(Scribes) Document:** Be attentive to the discussion and document the group's feedback on the focus areas, as directed by the Synod small group materials.
