

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Here are the tips on prayer that I spoke about in my homily this past weekend that I heard Father Jack Sweeney speak about in a talk in 1992:

- 1. Build upon your own strengths in prayer, use what has worked.
- 2. Have a prayer repertoire, different ways to pray that are helpful for different times and various moods (meditation, Scripture, rosary, liturgy of the hours, prayer in nature, and more).
- 3. Do not give up trying to pray, stay with it even when it doesn't seem to be working.
- 4. Avoid the desire for "success" in prayer.
- 5. Bring all of your emotions to your prayer: frustration, hope, anger, fear, joy, and other emotions. God wants you to open up with all of your emotions.
- 6. Our experience with God in prayer is sacred ground, and even if distractions come during prayer, set the distraction aside and refocus yourself.

Funeral Ushers Needed. With this past week, when we had three funerals, it becomes apparent how much we rely on volunteer ushers to help at funeral Masses. The time commitment is about 90 minutes per funeral, and the tasks include greeting visitors, helping people with questions, inviting people to be seated in the middle sections of the church, and other easy tasks. We will give you 3-4 days notice via email about upcoming funerals to see if you are available to help. We generally needed only one usher per funeral Mass. There are some weeks when we have no funerals, and some weeks when we have 1-3 funerals.
