Social Justice and Caring Committee—September Collection: Listening House

During September, items will be accepted for Listening House, a day shelter and community center located at 464 Maria Avenue in St. Paul (in the lower level of the First Lutheran Church). It provides hospitality, practical assistance, and counsel to people who are unsheltered or in need. This includes offering light food, clothing, help for those looking for employment and/or housing, and veterans' assistance. Staff and volunteers aspire to create a sense of community and connection by promoting respect for all and to help guests make changes to improve their condition. Items needed include:

- new boxer briefs for men (yes, just boxer briefs) M-XL
- new underwear for women (all sizes)
- new or freshly laundered bras
- new or used belts for men and women
- travel sized personal care including deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, hand sanitizer
- socks

Place items in the donation closet, located off the coat room, before and after Masses from September 1-26.

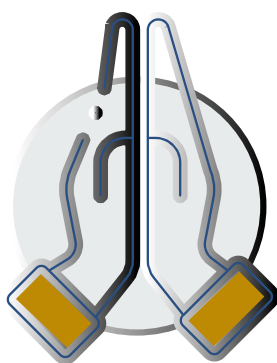
