Starting small group ministry in our parish is an exciting opportunity for us to extend and deepen the community of our parish and foster the relationships that we know make St. Pascal's such a special community. Groups of 6-10 members will meet weekly during Lent 2024 and be facilitated by small group leaders from our parish. Over the summer, our Synod Evangelization Team will be directly contacting more than 70 parishioners to invite them to be small group leaders.
