FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We welcome Sister Rose Okongwu to our parish this weekend to speak at all the Masses. She is a member of the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Mother of Christ. Sister Rose comes to us through the Missionary Cooperation Plan of the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. The Religious Institute of the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Mother of Christ was founded in Nigeria in 1937. The Sisters strive to imitate Christ in their humble and compassionate service to the poor. They help widows, single mothers and teenage mothers to find a safe place for themselves and their children. They provide shelter to homeless and abandoned children in their Hope Children Home in Kenya. They provide food and clothing to the poor, health care to the sick and vulnerable, educational opportunities to children, and pathways for sustainable livelihood among the needy. There will be a second collection at Mass this weekend to support the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. You may also give to the mission collection next weekend by writing "Mission Collection" on the front of a blank envelope and give with cash or a check made out to "St. Pascal Baylon Church" with "Mission collection" in the memo line. Reverently disposing of sacred objects. From time to time, people ask me what to do with old, tattered Bibles or broken rosaries. The following information was recently published by the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis: "Occasionally, the Office of Worship receives questions regarding what to do with blessed Bibles, old liturgical ritual books, rosaries, statues, altar linens, or other objects which have been blessed for sacred use but are no longer usable. Canon 1171 indicates, 'Sacred objects, which are designated for divine worship by dedication or blessing, are to be treated reverently and are not to be employed for profane (i.e. non-sacred, secular, ordinary) or inappropriate use even if they are owned by private persons.' If a blessed or dedicated item—or one that you believe may have been blessed or dedicated—has been broken or is otherwise past its useful life, you may dispose of it by burying it or by burning it and burying the ashes." (Archdiocesan Update, June 27, 2023).
