Fasting: On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics between the ages of 18 - 59 are allowed only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed, but solid foods between meals is not permitted. The physically and mentally ill and pregnant or nursing women are excused from fasting and abstinence.

Abstinence: Catholics 14 years or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and the Fridays of Lent.
