Small Groups are the Synod Priority for Year 1 (July 2023 - June 2024) with the purpose of creating and growing small group ministry at every parish in the Archdiocese to foster personal relationships, build community, and provide formation to help each of us as parishioners grow as missionary disciples of Christ.
