Lenten Regulations on Fasting

Fasting: On Ash Wednesday & Good Friday, Catholics between the ages of 18 - 60 are allowed only one full meal. Two smaller meals are allowed as needed, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Those excused from fasting and abstinence include the physically and mentally ill and pregnant or nursing women.

Abstinence: Catholics 14 years or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
