This weekend, June 3-4, St. Pascal's parish will gather the loose change and bills from the collection and donate them to the three options chosen by the committee for its summer projects:

Option 1: Holy Family Surgery Center at Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos Orphanage in Honduras

This surgery center is spearheaded by Dr. Peter Daly, an orthopedic surgeon from Minnesota. The center provides same day surgical procedures for underprivileged patients who otherwise could not afford surgery.

Option 2: Progressive Baptist Church Fishes and Loaves Food Shelf

This food shelf is located within Progressive Baptist Church at 1501 Burns Avenue in St. Paul. It provides emergency food items to anybody in need. No residency or parish memberships are required.

Option 3: The Listening House

The Listening House is a St. Paul inner-city drop-in center that provides hospitality and practical assistance to disadvantaged, homeless and lonely people.
