Qualified Charitable Distribution

Would you like to reduce your federal taxes/increase your refund?

Are you:

At least 70 1/2?

Taking Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) from an IRA? Donating to Holy Rosary Parish or other charity?

Then you are eligible to directly contribute some or all of your RMD from your IRA and reduce your taxable income! One result of the 2018 federal tax reform was to increase the standard deduction to \$12,000 for a single person and \$24,000 for a couple filing married/joint. Combined with the limited deduction for state and local taxes, these changes make it much more difficult to benefit from itemizing deductions versus taking the standard deduction.

However, by instructing your IRA custodian to transfer some or all of your RMD to Holy Rosary (or other charity), you can reduce your taxable income by the amount for the transfer. The amount donated will not be added into your income for tax purposes. Contributing in this manner allows you to reduce your income and still claim the standard deduction.

In addition, by reducing your adjusted gross income, this strategy may also reduce the amount of your social security benefits subject to tax.

The tax-free transfer won't count if you withdraw the money from the IRA first and then make a contribution to charity. You could still take a charitable deduction for your contribution in that case, but the IRA withdrawal will be included in your adjusted gross income. If you make a tax-free transfer from the IRA to charity, you can't also take that money as a charitable contribution. If you have any questions please check with your IRA custodian and/or your tax advisor.
