Pastor's Column

As St. Joseph Parish: Church & School begins its new fiscal year; I am excited to share some of the many positive changes taking place.

First, thank you again for all your efforts in making our **Raise the Roof** Initiative a great success. We surpassed our goal! Through donations and pledges, we raised over \$205,000. And because 70% of the monies has already come into the rectory office, we have already been able to:

- Repair and replace sections of the Church roof
- Purchase and install a new air conditioning unit for the Church
- Replace the rectory roof

More roofing work and other renovations will continue on the St. Joseph campus throughout the summer. I will keep you informed.



This year our Parish will focus on learning more about our parishioners and increasing participation in our ministries through our **COUNT ME IN!** Campaign. It kicks off with a Parish census that you may have already received in the mail. There will be copies of the census form in upcoming bulletins and here in the Church as well. You may also fill it out online at saintjoe.org/census. With so many changes in the way we communicate, it is about time we collect parishioner emails and cell phone numbers as well as check to ensure parishioner files are up-to-date. I ask that ALL households please complete and return their form as soon as possible. The paper form can be placed in the offertory collection or mailed to the rectory.

Another positive change is the growth of our staff. Please join me in welcoming **Jessica Plaspohl** as our new Parish Catechetical Leader (PCL). Jessica has a wealth of experience and was the previous Director of Faith Formation at St. Matthew Parish in Akron, OH. Jessica graduated from Archbishop Hoban High School and received her BA in Religious Studies from Ursuline College, Pepper Pike, OH. She continued her education by receiving a MA in Theology with a concentration in Catholic Bioethics/Moral Theology from Holy Apostles College and Seminary in Cromwell, CT. She currently is an Apprentice Cohort Leader for the Diocese of Cleveland and a member of the Midwest Holy Cross Associates Board of Directors.



Eric Eiermann, who has been our acting PCL, is moving into a new role as Advancement Coordinator. He will be focusing on enhancing our use of digital media as well as on grant writing.

Finally, with some sadness, I must announce that **Sue Dudek**, our Parish bookkeeper, will be retiring effective July 6. Sue not only has worked for St. Joseph Parish for 23 years, but she is an alumnus of the school and celebrated her marriage here. We congratulate Sue and wish her many blessings in her retirement. Although Sue cannot be replaced, we continue our search for a new bookkeeper.

I will provide you with more updates throughout the summer. St. Joseph Parish Mission: Believing in the universal call to holiness, we, the Roman Catholic community of Saint Joseph, will bring all to Christ through celebration of Word and Eucharist, reception of the sacraments, education, service, and community activities. Relying on God's grace and sharing our time, talent and treasure, we live our faith by serving God, the Church, our school and community.

BAPTISMS: Parents are expected to attend a Baptismal Meeting with our Deacon Kent before arranging for a Baptism. Please call the Rectory to arrange for a Meeting and Baptism date.

REGISTRATION: New parishioners are always welcome. We request that you stop at the Rectory or call 330-928-2173 to register.

HOSPITAL VISITS: St. Joseph is assigned to Summa Western Reserve Hospital. Please be sure to register as a Catholic when you enter any hospital or have a family member do so. Each hospital is assigned a Chaplain. The Chaplain Service of each hospital will take care of its own Sacramental duties. Patients and/or family members are asked to check at the appropriate nurse's station to ensure that the Chaplain has been notified.

SHUT-INS: If you are confined to your home and wish to receive the Sacraments, please call the Rectory. Normally, Eucharistic Ministers do bring Holy Communion to shut-ins. Also, if you (are a Shut-In and) would like to receive the bulletin, you can call the Rectory Office and request to have it mailed to you weekly.

ST. VINCENT de PAUL: This organization helps needy families and persons. Call the Rectory to request assistance.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROSPECTIVE CONVERTS & CATHOLICS:

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

This process of becoming a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church begins in the Fall and culminates with the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Meetings are held once a week. For more information call the Rectory.

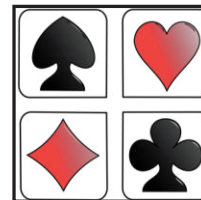

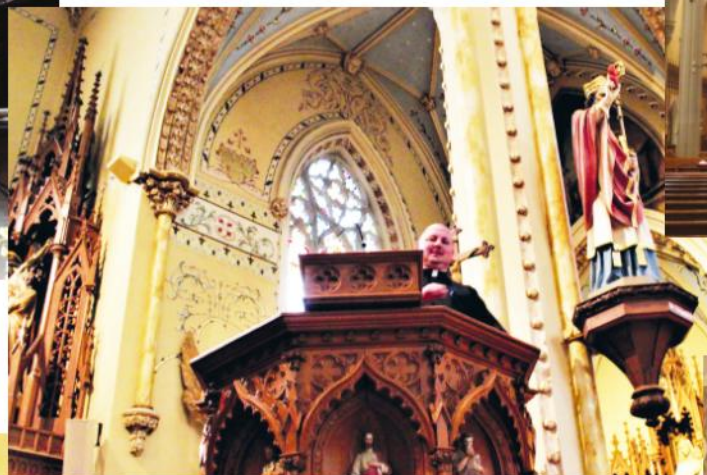
