





Pastor's Column





Last week in the Pastor's column I mentioned we are running the COUNT ME IN! campaign for this new fiscal year. COUNT ME IN! is designed to gather and update the data of our parish families; to identify and better serve your needs; to discover the talents and skills within the parish; and to improve the works of our ministries and organizations.

During the first phase of **COUNT ME IN!**, the St. Joseph staff and I want to better understand the needs of our Parish families and get to know them better. To remind parishioners of the **COUNT ME IN!** campaign throughout the summer, this is also the theme of our annual raffle and Parish picnic. All households will receive raffle tickets in the next week, and don't forget to mark your calendar for the Parish picnic taking place on *Sunday*, *August 19th, at the Big Cuyahoga Pavilion in the Waterworks complex*.

During the second phase of **COUNT ME IN!**, we will examine how well our current ministries and organizations provide opportunities to YOU for fellowship, spiritual growth, and stewardship. It's my responsibility, as a pastor, to help parishioners see their potential, use their God-given gifts, and grow in their discipleship. Each member of our parish is unique, and plays a particular role in the body of Christ.

The **COUNT ME IN!** Campaign will help determine how best St. Joseph Parish can serve you, how best our congregation can serve the community, and most importantly how best you and I can serve Christ.

I pray that all of us take time to reflect and identify the gifts God has given to us and understand those gifts are meant to be shared with others. This will be an exciting year of discovery, participation, and change.

St. Joseph Parish Mission: Believing in the universal call to holiness, we, the Roman Catholic community of Saint Joseph, will bring all to Christ through celebration of Word and Eucharist, reception of the sacraments, education, service, and community activities. Relying on God's grace and sharing our time, talent and treasure, we live our faith by serving God, the Church, our school and community.

BAPTISMS: Parents are expected to attend a Baptismal Meeting with our Deacon Kent before arranging for a Baptism. Please call the Rectory to arrange for a Meeting and Baptism date.

REGISTRATION: New parishioners are always welcome. We request that you stop at the Rectory or call 330-928-2173 to register.

HOSPITAL VISITS: St. Joseph is assigned to Summa Western Reserve Hospital. Please be sure to register as a Catholic when you enter any hospital or have a family member do so. Each hospital is assigned a Chaplain. The Chaplain Service of each hospital will take care of its own Sacramental duties. Patients and/or family members are asked to check at the appropriate nurse's station to ensure that the Chaplain has been notified.

SHUT-INS: If you are confined to your home and wish to receive the Sacraments, please call the Rectory. Normally, Eucharistic Ministers do bring Holy Communion to shut-ins. Also, if you (are a Shut-In and) would like to receive the bulletin, you can call the Rectory Office and request to have it mailed to you weekly.

ST. VINCENT de PAUL: This organization helps needy families and persons. Call the Rectory to request assistance.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROSPECTIVE CONVERTS & CATHOLICS:

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)




Did vou notice the CENSUS FORM in last week's Bulletin?!
