Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence

Application for the 2019-2020 School Year

Eight \$3,000 Scholarships to current 10th and 11th grade students applicable to their 11th & 12th grade years respectively

Sixteen \$1,000 scholarships to current 6th & 7th grade students applicable to their 7th & 8th grade years respectively

The Catholic Education Endowment Trust (CEET) was established in 1976 by the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland to promote Catholic education, provide support for religious programs, and to offer tuition aid and scholarships to families with financial need who desired a Catholic education for their children. As part of this initiative, CEET started the *Bishops' Scholarship* to encourage *Excellence* in Catholic education.

Guidelines/Criteria

- The family is required to complete a FACTS Grant and Aid application for 2019-20 to determine need; https://online.factsmgt.com/aid
- If a family has more than one child applying for the *Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence*, a separate application must be completed for each child.
- The completed Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence application should include:
 - 1. An essay written by the student, (minimum of two pages/maximum of three pages, typed and double-spaced, and no staples please) on the topic:

Bishop Perez echoes Pope Francis' call for us to be "Missionary Disciples" by sharing what excites us about our faith as we encounter people in everyday life. In your essay, share 3-5 things about your Catholic school experience that excite you. Explain how these everyday experiences place you on the path to living your faith and fulfilling the call from God in your life.

- 2. The student's academic transcript or current report card attached.
- 3. A brief written recommendation e.g., from a teacher, guidance counselor, or a parish staff member (not a family member) on page 4.
- 4. Principal comments and the principal's signature on page 5.
- Applications must be returned to the student's principal by March 1, 2019
- Principals must submit the applications to the Office of Catechetical Formation and Education by March 15, 2019. *Principals pick the top 5 applicants per school to send in.
- Recipients will be notified by mail if a *Bishops' Scholarship for Excellence* has been awarded. A copy of the letter will also be sent to the student's principal.

*Please note: all recipients, their parents, principal, and pastor will be invited to an awards ceremony and luncheon which takes place on June 24, 2019. Invitations will be included with award letters.
