ADULT WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM

C.O.O.L. Project Completion

In the event that an act of service cannot be completed at the C.O.O.L. Day Project, I understand that any additional services or activities necessary to complete the project must be finalized by June 30 of the year referenced above ("C.O.O.L. Project Completion Period"). Any additional services or activities performed after the termination of the C.O.O.L. Project Completion Period shall be the sole responsibility of the church and/or individual(s) providing the additional services. All responsibility and oversight offered by C.O.O.L. during the C.O.O.L. Day Project and the C.O.O.L. Project Completion Period shall terminate on June 30 of the year referenced above.

Financial Responsibility

I affirm that I am at least 18 years of age, and that I am volunteering my services for the C.O.O.L. Day Project and/or the C.O.O.L. Project Completion Period. I acknowledge that as a result of my participation in the C.O.O.L. Day Project and/or the C.O.O.L. Project Completion Period, I may suffer injury, illness, or damages to my person or my property or both ("Injury"). I accept full responsibility for all costs and expenses incurred by me as a result of any such Injury.

MINOR VOLUNTEER WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM (to be authorized by Parent or Legal Guardian: "Adult")

Project Completion Period, Minor Volunteer may suffer injury, illness, or damages to his/her person or his/her property or both ("Injury"). Adult accepts full responsibility for all costs and expenses incurred by Minor Volunteer as a result of any such Injury.
