Ms. Haidnick was a lifetime member of St. Joseph Parish prior to her passing on October 14, 2018, at the age of 96! It was Ms. Haidnick's hope to assist current and future St. Joseph students in obtaining an excellent Catholic education as was provided for herself and six brothers and sisters.

- Two \$500 Catholicity scholarships will be awarded.
- St. Joseph students in grades 5, 6, and 7 are eligible to compete.

Eligibility: The student must be currently enrolled at St. Joseph Parish School and must actively participate in all aspects of worship available through school. The student will be a positive, contributing member of the class and works to serve others.

Requirements: Students must write a three paragraph essay on how the **Tenets of a St. Joseph Student** are helping them become successful students, developing their character, and demonstrating their faith in action as they grow in relationship with Jesus.

Deadline: Completed applications and essays must be returned to the school office no later than **Thursday**, **May 23**, **2019**. A scholarship committee consisting of the pastor, principal, associate principal, and two teachers will review the essays and award the scholarships in time for the next academic year. Essays may be typed or neatly written and attached to this page.
