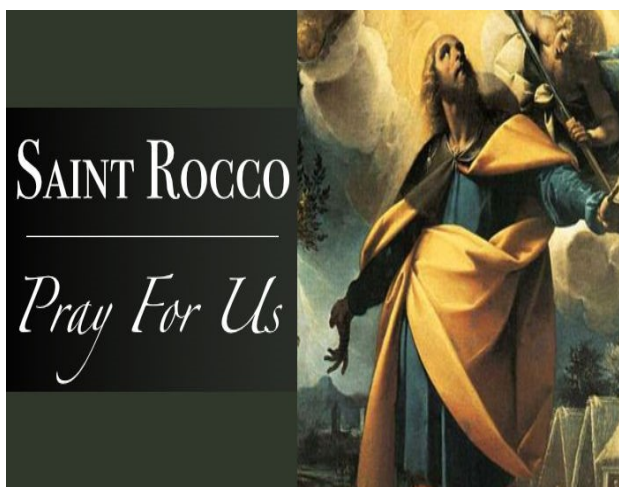

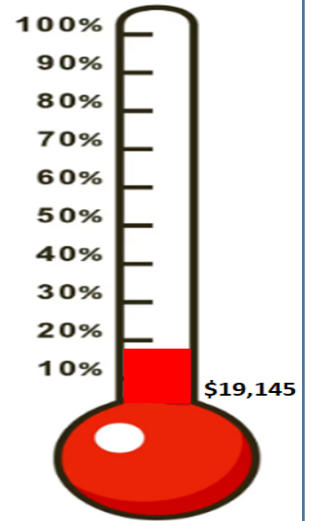
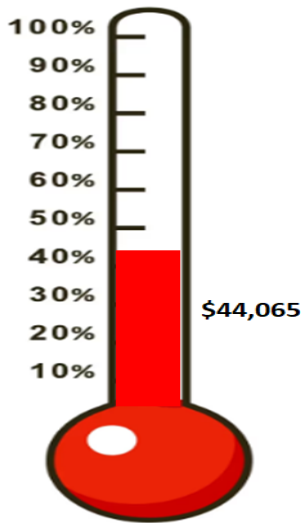

Sabiduría 18, 6-9

Esta lectura está situada en el contexto de una celebración de la Pascua judía, en la que se reflexiona y se recuerda la salida de los israelitas de Egipto y la décima plaga. En castigo a la decisión de matar a los primogénitos israelitas, los egipcios pierden a los suyos. Los israelitas salen ganando de las plagas que afligieron a Egipto.



Hay aquí un largo y detallado relato de los personajes que sufrieron pruebas y las superaron por la fe; fueron marginados, excluidos, perseguidos, torturados y asesinados; pero Dios recompensará sus sufrimientos, porque el mundo no era digno de ellos.



Lucas 12, 32-48

Se da a esta parábola un sentido de parusía. El relato aparece en otras formas, en otros evangelios; pero aquí el esclavo es administrador de los bienes. Tiene una aplicación pedagógica para sus apóstoles, en la intención de Jesús: se adscribe una responsabilidad especial a quienes han recibido el mensaje y sus fallos serán castigados.



No es poca cosa y fortuna saber dónde está nuestro corazón y nuestro tesoro y saber redirigirlo. Si nuestro tesoro está en cosas pequeñas, como el dinero, la propia posición u opinión, pequeñeces, el corazón acabará encogido y distraído de lo que en verdad es importante. Entonces podría llegar Dios a nuestra vida y encontrarnos distantes, fríos y distraídos con cosas poco dignas de las personas que somos creadas nada menos que a imagen de Dios. Si nuestro corazón está en cosas más altas y generosas, como el bien y el servicio de Dios y de los demás, Dios nos encontrará vigilantes y esperándole; y nuestra alegría será completa. entonces sí que podremos decir que contamos con un inmenso tesoro, que además nadie nos podrá arrebatar.

La solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María fue fijada en el 15 de agosto ya en el siglo V, con el sentido de "Nacimiento al Cielo" o, en la tradición bizantina, "Dormición" de Nuestra Señora. En Roma, la fiesta se

celebra desde mediados del siglo VII, pero hubo que esperar hasta el 1 de noviembre de 1950, con Pío XII, para que se proclamara el dogma dedicado a María asunta al cielo en cuerpo y alma. En el Credo Apostólico profesamos nuestra fe en la "Resurrección de la carne" y en la "vida eterna", fin y sentido último del camino de la vida. Esta promesa de fe se cumple ya en María, como "signo de consuelo y esperanza segura" (Prefacio). Este privilegio de María está estrechamente ligado al

hecho de ser la Madre de Jesús: dado que la muerte y la corrupción del cuerpo humano son una consecuencia del pecado, no era conveniente que la Virgen María -libre de pecado- se viera afectada por ellos. De ahí el misterio de la "Dormición" o "Asunción al Cielo". El hecho de que María esté ya en el cielo en cuerpo y alma es para nosotros un motivo de alegría, de felicidad, de esperanza. Una criatura de Dios -María- ya está en el cielo: con ella y como ella estaremos también nosotros, criaturas de Dios, un día. El destino de María, unida al cuerpo transfigurado y glorioso de Jesús, será el destino de todos los que están unidos al Señor Jesús en la fe y en el amor. Es interesante constatar que la liturgia -a través de los textos bíblicos tomados del libro del Apocalipsis y de Lucas, con el canto del *Magnificat*- nos lleva a orar más que a reflexionar. El Evangelio, en efecto, nos sugiere que leamos el misterio de María a la luz del *Magnificat*: el amor gratuito que se

extiende de generación en generación y la predilección por los últimos y los pobres encuentran en María su mejor fruto, su obra maestra, un espejo en el que todo el pueblo de Dios puede mirar sus propios rasgos. La solemnidad de la Asunción al Cielo de la Santísima Virgen María en cuerpo y alma es el signo elocuente de que no sólo el alma sino también el cuerpo son "cosa muy hermosa" (Gn 1,31), hasta el punto de que, como en la Virgen María, nuestra carne será asumida en el cielo. Esto no nos exime de comprometernos con la historia; al contrario, es precisamente la mirada hacia la meta, hacia el cielo, nuestra patria, la que nos impulsa a comprometernos en nuestra vida presente siguiendo la línea del Magnificat: alegres por la misericordia de Dios y atentos a todos los hermanos que encontramos en el camino, empezando por los más débiles y frágiles.
