Eclesiástico 3, 17-18, 20, 28-29

Hebreos 12, 18-19, 22-24

Lucas 14, 1, 7-14

La sabiduría griega parecía consistir en saber muchas cosas y dominar muchos conocimientos académicos; frente a esto se sitúa la sabiduría bíblica en la que el sabio es consciente de que le falta mucho por aprender; tal humildad atrae el amor de los demás y la compasión de Dios, ya que Dios revela sus pensamientos a los más humildes. Para los israelitas, la sabiduría consistía en temer a Dios, cumpliendo sus mandatos.



La visión de la nueva alianza tiene ecos proféticos. Se sitúa como contraste el Monte Sinaí, donde Moisés confiesa su temblor ante el fuego ardiente y la tempestad, y la montaña

santa hacia la que peregrinan los cristianos. esa ciudad santa ya tiene ciudadanos residentes: todos los ángeles, los justos del Antiguo Testamento, y todos los hombres de buena voluntad de toda raza, lengua y nación.



El proverbio de quien se exalta será humillado, en todas sus formas parece indicar el cambio de papeles que ocurrirá en el reino de Dios. Lucas lo utiliza para indicar cómo serán las cosas al final. La llamada a una conducta humilde es como una advertencia escatológica, que mira hacia el banquete celestial, y es también una llamada a renunciar al orgullo y la vanidad ante Dios.



Humildad tiene la misma raíz latina que la palabra humus, es decir, suelo. El humilde está cercano al suelo y eso significa que es realista, que se sabe acercar a los verdaderos problemas, las limitaciones y necesidades de las personas en su alrededor. No se levanta sobre los demás ni hace valer su autoridad, su prestigio o su fama; Tales personas grandes, es decir, humildes y sencillas, son las que saben que todo lo que son y tienen está en función del servicio a los demás, porque nada de lo que se tiene es por derecho o mérito propio, sino por la gracia de Dios; y no se tiene para sí mismo, sino para los demás.

Quiero aprender de Ti,

La humildad es una ley del Reino de los Cielos, una virtud que Cristo predica a lo largo de todo el Evangelio. En este pasaje de San Lucas, Cristo nos invita a dejar de pensar en nosotros mismos para poder pensar en los demás. ¿Por

qué? Los que se ensalzan a sí mismos sólo piensan en sus propios intereses y en que la gente se fije en ellos y hablen de ellos. Eso se llama egoísmo, un fruto del pecado capital de la soberbia. Y un alma soberbia nunca entrará en el Reino de Dios, porque el soberbio no puede unirse a Dios. ¿Cuál es la motivación que da Jesús para la vivencia de la humildad? El amor a los demás, al prójimo. La razón es que yo, al dejar de ocupar los primeros puestos, o ceder el querer ser el más importante, estoy dejando el lugar de importancia a mi hermano o hermana. Se trata de un acto de caridad oculta, que sólo Dios ve y, ciertamente, será recompensado con creces. Esta es la actitud que Cristo nos invita a vivir hoy. A dejar a mis hermanos los mejores puestos por amor a ellos y a Dios. Cristo mismo nos dio el ejemplo, cuando lavó los pies a los discípulos, siendo que los discípulos eran los que debían lavar los pies a Cristo. Podemos vivir hoy la virtud de la humildad, dejando de pensar en nosotros mismos y dando nuestra preferencia al prójimo.
