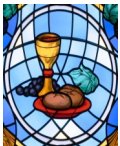

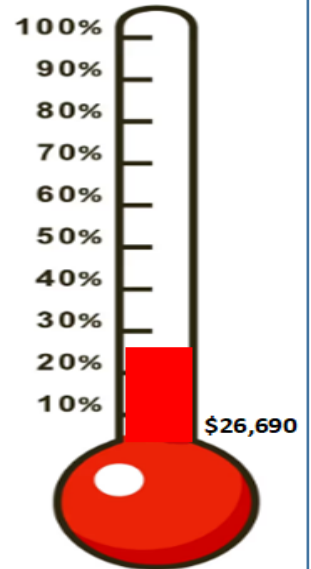
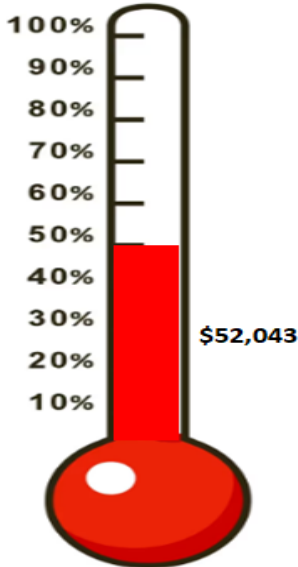

XXIV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario: La fidelidad de Dios es por siempre



Éxodo 32, 7-11, 13-14

El relato deja al descubierto dos realidades: la fidelidad de Dios y la versatilidad constante del pueblo. La firmeza de Dios en su proyecto y la franca flaqueza y debilidad del hombre. Estos dos elementos van a conducir la historia de la salvación a lo largo de los siglos. Y la historia humana de los hombres de todos los tiempos.

1 Timoteo 1, 12-17

El autor coloca la acción de gracias que solía encabezar el asunto de las cartas cuando ya ha comenzado a desarrollar el tema, con el fin de dar más fuerza a sus instrucciones



como pastor de la comunidad. ¿Cuáles son las intenciones al presentar esta especie de autorretrato del antes blasfemo Pablo? Quizá darle credibilidad a la carta, que posiblemente no sea del propio Pablo. El que Pablo se llame a sí mismo arrogante suena más como la palabra de un observador cercano. La alabanza de la misericordia de Cristo es paulina, pero parece más una antología de dichos de Pablo que una carta de él mismo. La doxología final mezcla elementos hebreos y griegos: Rey de los tiempos, el único Dios, inmortal e invisible. Esto es una marca bastante característica del judaísmo helénico.



Lucas 15, 1-32

Las dos parábolas anteriores a la del hijo pródigo parecen ser muy reales en la cultura palestina. Una oveja de cien podría ser considerada perdida por culpa del pastor y una moneda de diez podría haber sido una parte considerable de la dote de una mujer. Hasta el último siglo, las mujeres nómadas eran frecuentemente representadas con las monedas firmemente cosidas a su tocado de cabeza. La celebración del vecindario por la recuperación es también real. Lucas expande la explicación de Mateo como imagen del gozo del padre de que no se pierda nadie.



Como los israelitas en el desierto, como Saulo o como la oveja que deja a su grupo para andar errante, nosotros a veces nos formamos nuestros propios ídolos con los que sustituimos a quien de verdad nos quiere. Luego nos parece incluso imposible, cuando queremos regresar, que se nos perdone. La fidelidad sin condiciones y el perdón pueden parecer extraños e incluso extravagantes; pero son parte de la naturaleza de Dios. Dios es amor.

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Después está escrito que el Señor es "compasivo" en el sentido que nos concede la gracia, tiene compasión y, en su grandeza, se inclina sobre quien es débil y pobre, siempre listo para acoger, comprender y perdonar. Es como el padre de la parábola del Evangelio de san Lucas: un padre que no se cierra en el resentimiento por el abandono del hijo menor, sino que al contrario continúa esperándolo —lo ha generado— y después corre a su encuentro y lo abraza, no lo deja ni siquiera terminar su confesión —como si le cubriera la boca—, qué grande es el amor y la alegría por haberlo reencontrado; y después va también a llamar al hijo mayor, que está indignado y no quiere hacer fiesta, el hijo que ha permanecido siempre en la casa, pero viviendo como un siervo más que como un hijo, y también sobre él el padre se inclina, lo invita a entrar, busca abrir su corazón al amor, para que ninguno quede excluido de la fiesta de la misericordia. ¡La misericordia es una fiesta! De este Dios misericordioso se dice también que es "lento a la ira",

literalmente, "largo en su respiración", es decir, con la respiración amplia de paciencia y de la capacidad de soportar. Dios sabe esperar, sus tiempos no son aquellos impacientes de los hombres; Él es como un sabio agricultor que sabe esperar, deja tiempo a la buena semilla para que crezca, a pesar de la cizaña. (Homilía de S.S. Francisco, 13 de enero de 2016). **Reflexión:** Sabiendo que somos hijos de Dios pensamos que lo merecemos todo. A veces no somos ni capaces de agradecer a nuestro Creador por el gran don de la vida. Y, mucho menos, nos esforzamos por corresponder a su amor infinito. ¿Cuánto hemos recibido de Dios? ¡Todo! Sin embargo lo vemos como una obligación de parte de Él. Podríamos llegar a quejarnos cuando no recibimos lo que queremos y tal vez hasta hemos llegado al punto de exigirle. Dios, en su infinita bondad, no cesa de colmarnos de sus gracias y hasta cumple con nuestros caprichos. No importa si le agradecemos o no. Lo más hermoso es ver que Dios

no se cansa y por mucho que nos alejemos de Él, cuando deseamos volver, ahí está con los brazos abiertos esperándonos con un corazón lleno de amor.

Dios es el Pastor que se alegra al encontrar la oveja perdida. Él es el Padre misericordioso que espera a su hijo perdido con grandes ansias, le perdona cualquier falta cuando ve un verdadero arrepentimiento y lo llena de su amor. Digamos a Cristo: "Señor Tú lo sabes todo tu sabes que te quiero". Señor y Padre mío, con qué facilidad puedo engañarme a mí mismo al seguir el camino fácil que me ofrece la vida y ser un ciego y sordo indiferente a las necesidades de los demás, para concentrarme sólo en mi propia felicidad. Dame tu gracia para saber mantenerme siempre a tu lado. Que no me aleje de tu gracia, porque entonces mi corazón se convertirá en roca, insensible a recibir y corresponder a tu amor. Libremente quiero depender siempre y en todo de Ti
