**Secretary's Report** The September 2025 minutes were reviewed by all those attending. No corrections were noted. Julie Malone made a motion to accept the minutes and Dianne Forville seconded. All approved.

**Old Business**

West side door replacement – Waiting to get a quote.

New Floor Scrubber – A new floor cleaner that vacuums and mops was purchased. It will be used at both churches and social halls. The cost was \$4,303.63 and will be split among the Mens Club, Ladies Club, Knights of Columbus and the Soup Kitchen. Our share is \$1,075.91. The church will be reimbursed; Julie will tell Erin to take our amount due out of our gaming account.

**New Business**

New Robes for Altar Servers – An inventory of the robes for both churches was done. It was determined there was a need for sizes 16 and 18. A purchase was made and between the two churches we have three size 16 and 3 size 18. Total cost was \$495.81. The robes have been received and are very nice.

New racks for holding chairs – Discussion was held regarding any interest in purchasing new chair racks. Discussion points included where to store as new racks are made taller than what we currently have. Also, the number of chairs each rack would hold is a concern. It was determined that more research needs to be conducted before making any decisions.

Paper Cutter – Discussion was held regarding the blade of the current paper cutter. It is getting very dull and doesn't always cut smoothly. It needs to be determined if the blade/handle can be removed for sharpening or if a new cutter needs to be purchased. This is currently on hold.

2025 Cookie Walk December 13<sup>th</sup> – Another item has been added for the raffle. In addition to the items listed we will also be getting an Air Fryer. Also it has not yet been determined if the fleece blankets will be available or not.

Once all the prizes are finalized the raffle tickets will be created, stuffed and mailed to all parishioners. The sign-up sheets will be placed in the pews the first two weeks of November with a return date of December 1<sup>st</sup>.
