

Masking while at Mass: As you are probably aware, the governor has relaxed the rules about face coverings. Those rules now allow fully vaccinated persons to forego wearing masks indoors.

However, to respect those persons who feel more comfortable maintaining masking and social distancing when coming to Mass—and in compliance with the latest liturgical directives from the Archdiocese—I've designated the entire north half of our church nave (the side with the Stations) especially for them. The rest of the church, the Vercelli Room, and the Activity Center all provide sufficient space to allow people to sit as they wish: distanced or not, with face coverings or not.

Also, for the sake of persons who might have concerns, the clergy and the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will continue to wear masks while distributing Holy Communion.
