## FEBRUARY 18, 2024 THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT



Dear friends,

Well we had a great day of celebration last Sunday. It was such a joy to have a church filled with people giving thanks for all that has been accomplished this past year in fixing up our church.

And all this was topped off with a great meal and some wonderful times sharing the day with others.

Thanks to **Chick Duncan** and the other members of the planning committee: **Amelia Hartz, Joan Inkenbrandt, Darlene Appler, Donna Blankenberger, Toni Askins, Susan Helmer, Jean Duncan and Greg Head.** Thanks to all the folks who came last Saturday morning to help set up the gym and for all the folks who stayed after the dinner to put everything away. From start to finish, it was just a great job!

And the icing on the cake has to be that our long awaited carpet has finally arrived and is scheduled to be installed this week. You can help with this as well. Today (Sunday) we will gather in church at 12:30 to take all the chairs back to the storage room off of the gym. We will also be bringing all the pews from the storage building to church. If you can help, just show up. Once they have installed the carpet in the center aisle of the church we will begin to install the pews. We don't have an exact time for this, but if you are willing to help, call Bob Fehrenbacher (812-453-0669) and let him know.

Once all the pews are installed we can then get the exact measurements for the new kneelers. It will likely take some time for them to be manufactured and sent to us for installation. With those projects complete, the only remaining items to be completed on the church are the installation of the new handrails along the handicapped entrance to the west side of the church, the installation of the main louvers in the steeple and the reinstallation of our regilded cross. All these projects are in the works and we are just waiting for good weather for the final installation work to be completed.

Now we are continuing the Season of Lent. Here is something I read in my daily prayer. *Lent is a call to weep for what we could have been and are not. Lent is the grace to grieve for what we should have done and did not. Lent is the opportunity to change what we ought to change but have not. Lent is not about penance. Lent is about becoming, doing and changing whatever it is that is blocking the fullness of life in us right now. Lent is a summons to live anew.*

*The first challenge of Lent is to open ourselves to life. When we "rend our hearts" we break them open to things we are refusing for some warped reason to even consider. We have refused for years, perhaps, to even think about renewing old commitments that we've allowed to go to dust—spending time with the children, visiting our parents, exercising, taking time to read good books. We've closed our minds, maybe, to the thought of reconciling with old friends whom we have hurt. We've refused to put the effort into reviving old spiritual practices like visits to church, meditation in the morning, the memorization of the psalms, that we allowed to die in our youth but failed to substitute for as we aged. We've failed to repent old abrasions, quick words, harsh judgments made in haste and expiated never. We have closed the doors of our hearts, as time went by, to so many of the things we need to live full and holy lives.*

*Lent is the time to let life in again, to rebuild the worlds we've allowed to go sterile, to "fast and weep and mourn" for the goods we've foregone. If our own lives are not to die from lack of nourishment, we must sacrifice the pride or the sloth or the listlessness that blocks us from beginning again. Then, as Joel promises, God will have pity on us and pour into our hearts the life we know down deep that we are lacking.*

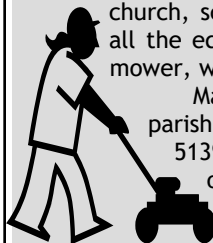
