Thanks to all who have made their pledge to our "Rebuilding our Church" campaign. 42% of our families have pledged \$622,230. That is just phenomenal. What a great sign of the love you have for our parish. I'm hoping that the other 58% of our families will want to join us in this effort as well. And we are going to need their help.

Whenever you start doing a rebuilding effort, there are always things that come up that you didn't expect and you find out that often the cost you first thought it would take to do the job is a lot less than what it actually costs. We've found this out as well as we have had to deal with the storm windows covering our stain glass windows as well as the louvers in the bell tower. and also some unexpected electrical issues. They are not necessarily big things by themselves but they add up.

The folks on our rebuilding committee want to make sure we take care of all the things that are needed to get our church is good shape and we want to make sure these things are done well so they will last well into the future. The money you have pledged gives us the confidence to move ahead in this direction. We don't want to cut corners and then have to deal with the consequences of that in a few years.

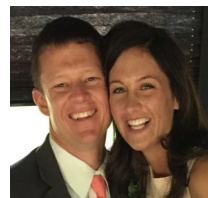
