# Human Concerns liaison Sue Laskowski -

 Have a concern about needing volunteers to assist with home visits for communion (within all 3 parishes), contact Fr. Ryan if you are interested in training. It's good for parishioners to know this is available for their family members. Very flexible to work with your schedule.

### **Evangelization and Formation Liaison Megan Cash:**

- REP-: We've set our calendars for the next school year, so registration for programs and the calendars should be on the website soon,
- VBC- We're looking for two more adult volunteers. It runs August 4-8 in the mornings at St. Joseph. Registration forms are in all the churches. There is a limit for campers this year to make sure everyone has a quality experience.
- OCIA: Mystagogy did not go well this year because everyone's schedules conflicted. Ellie mentioned that mystagogy is only needed for those being baptized at the Vigil, so Colleen only needs to focus on those situations for Mystagogy. The Corpus Christi reception is still planned for after the 10:30 am mass at St. Mary on June 22
- Hispanic Ministry: Pentecost included 5 Confirmations so it is great for the community to participate.
- Adoration schedule:
  - July 31: St. Charles, Fr. Ryan 7:00-8:00PM: Holy Hour for Hope.
  - o September TBD: for teachers and students.
  - o October 16: Adoration for All Tall & Small 7:00-8:00PM
  - o November TBD: Fr Jim will preside at an All Souls Adoration
  - $\circ$  December: December 11 7pm to Friday December 12 by 7am. 12 hours of Adoration for Our Lady of Guadalupe
- Small Group Formation: July 27 outdoor mass: There will be a Survey to gauge interest and determine good meeting times for small groups.
- Bible series: Fr. Ryan. 4 Wednesdays from August 8th -August 27: Read through "Dei Verbum"
- Young Adult Ministry: discussion on bulletin announcements from St. Francis
- "Walk With One": flyer was developed for this evangelization initiative. It would work
  best as an insert during a weekend when the homilies speak towards evangelization and
  encourage parishioners to read the bulletin insert for more directions on how to walk
  with someone in faith, taking steps closer to Jesus. Coordination with both Fr Jim and Fr
  Ryan is necessary
- Catholic Social Teaching: Fr Ryan shared the seven themes of Catholic Social Teaching.
  There are short videos available. We discussed how to promote this and like Fr Ryan's
  idea of a gathering for Pope Leo's 70th birthday on Sunday September 14. We need to
  decide on a location and time
- Lenten Mission Potential dates March 15-17
- Walk With One: talked about how we can bring people in from outside our parishes, trying to incorporate more

### Stewardship/Parish Life liaison Julie Mermal:

 RSVPs for the retreat were due June 6th, let Julie know if you can make it or not if you have not already RVSPed

### **Burlington Catholic School Board of Directors liaison Maddy Miller:**

- Enrollment is 416 and 80 choice students

- Budget is tight over the summer but should be ok once income starts coming back in August.
