- Mission Objectives and Personal Pledges: Retreat Review
 - 17 of 20 people invited participated, we are planning on meeting again in the future to discuss the retreat, one hour on a Sunday
 - Fr. Jim recommends having another retreat next year. The September retreat was a good time because it prepares us for the new school year and it allows new Pastoral Council members to join
 - Using our gifts: being open to the Holy Spirit, giving people permission to lead how they see fit, personal pledges (goals we set for ourselves), and how we are growing and meeting these goals
 - Communication with parishioners: current events, stories to highlight, asking someone at BCS to have a student create a newsletter of events that have happened to share with parishioners (maybe once a month newsletter).
 - ACTION ITEM: Maddy- talk to Emily to see if there would be a student or several students that would be interested in being involved with the newsletter idea.
 Could be a good way for those who don't use social media to see updates in BCS.
 Current school and parishioner events
 - Create a standing mission statement to be on the agenda every month
 - Each liaison bullet point could also have this. The liaison could ask at every meeting if there is anyone who wants to share a personal pledge they have
- Julie handed out a resource from the Archdiocese about our roles in parish life and what our purpose looks like as a council. We are encouraged to see where the spirit is guiding us to help out in the Tri-parish. Our presence and willingness to help allows us to notice gifts in other people as well.
- We have an opportunity for Called and Gifted, St. Thomas is interested in hosting and will open to other Catholic churches in the area. Various people come to speak about each talent and the signs of that talent in your life. Get a one-on-one meeting with a spiritual director. St. Thomas is thinking of doing this for their Lenten Mission. 2 weeks long, 3 hours for each meeting. The third week is the one-on-one meetings. We need to let St. Thomas know if we are interested. This is for all parishioners. Could advertise in the bulletin if we decide to move forward with this, \$40 per person.

Burlington Catholic School Board of Directors liaison Maddy Miller:

- Enrollment: 428 students
- St. Thomas preschool closed, picked up 8 families, still trying to reach out to the families who were going to attend St. Thomas (40 families).
- Trying to get the parish more involved in the school
- Smooth start to the beginning of the school year

- Talked about the shooting in Minneapolis- got some direction from the Archdiocese, putting in some safety features, especially when kids are in church. The school has never done a drill while in the church, so this is something that is under consideration
- Blue Jean Ball in April
- St. Peter's school closed

Finance:

St. Charles liaison Laura Freeburn:

- Confidential financial account: person who worked there wasn't getting back to us. We terminated our account with the accounting firm. St. Charles got an extension for the late payment
- B&G: repairing the parking lot, ongoing storage problems (for the activities that are happening). Is there a possibility of a physical library coming back for the school? We unfortunately don't have a room for a library.
- Fire escapes: there is a temporary ladder there until we are able to replace the fire escapes
- Festival: volunteers are down this year, should've gotten an email from Mary Labadie (going out to the tri-parish parishioners). Sign up sheets from the weekend did not inspire parishioners to sign up

St. Joseph liaison Janna Tichenor:

- Finished their summer renovating, updated some sidewalks, discussed security issues and electronic keys and fobs. The roof of rectory may be the next big project
- Financial report was processed
