

<u>Do</u>	<u>DON'T</u>
<p>Do read the handout sheets provided at the door:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>How to Protect Yourself and Others</u> • <u>Dos and Don'ts</u> (this sheet) 	<p>Don't leave these handout sheets in the pews when you leave</p> <p>Don't put them back at the door – either take them with you or throw them away</p>
<p>Do wear whatever personal protective equipment (PPE) that makes you feel safe and comfortable, including: face mask, gloves, etc.</p>	<p>Don't expect any PPEs to be provided – if you want these you must bring them with you</p>
<p>Do use the hand sanitizer provided before entering and when leaving the church</p>	
<p>Do keep distance between yourself and others who come in to pray – at least 6 feet (approximately two arm-lengths)</p>	<p>Don't sit next to others who are not members of your family or immediate household</p>
<p>Do limit unnecessarily touching pews and other areas inside the church</p>	<p>Don't allow children to roam around unsupervised</p>
<p>Do cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue or use the inside of your elbow</p>	<p>Don't leave used tissues in the pew, take them with you and throw them in the trash on your way out</p> <p>Don't forget to wash your hands or use hand sanitizer afterward</p>
<p>Do avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands</p>	
<p>Do try and limit the length of time you spend inside the church so that it doesn't become overly crowded</p>	<p>Don't forget others also want to pray safely, without being crowded</p>
