Weekday Communion Services

7:30-8am and 9-9:30am (main church)

Weekend Masses – TBA

Saturday Vigil Masses: 3:30pm and 5:00pm

Sunday Masses: 7:30, 9:00, 10:30am and (12noon in Spanish)

Private Prayer

Monday-Friday in the Chapel 10am until 2pm

Strict social distancing is required during this time. Parishioners are encouraged to:

- Be aware of social distancing – 6 ft apart
- If sitting alone, sit one person per kneeler
- Families may sit together, but must have a pew between you and the person in front and in back of you
- Wear masks if at all possible
- Use the hand sanitizer available at window sills
- No singing during Mass – the Cantor will sing for us
- No sign of peace, or holding hands during the Lord's Prayer
- Receiving Communion in the hand is **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED**
- Keep one line for communion (instead of two) per side
- Stay 6 ft behind the person in front of you during communion
- Upon leave of the church please leave the campus and not converse in the parking lot; ***we don't want people breaking social distancing by gathering in the parking lot.***
- Parishioners are still encouraged to stay home when ill
- Those who feel they still wish to stay home and watch Mass on TV or Computer still have a dispensation to do so.
