LETTER OF ELIGIBILITY REQUIRED

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states "Candidates for Confirmation, as for Baptism, fittingly seek the spiritual help of a sponsor. To emphasize the unity of the two sacraments, it is appropriate that this be one of the baptismal godparents." (CCC #1311). The Code of Canon Law, the rules that govern the specifics of Catholic Church functions, defines eligibility to be a sponsor as first being chosen by the one to be confirmed, second to be at least 16 years old, and third "be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on." Leading a life of faith as a Catholic means actively participating in a parish; Catholicism can't be lived independent of the Church.

Thus, we require that everyone chosen to be a sponsor provide us a Letter of Eligibility <u>provided by their parish</u>. This practice is quite common and provided that a sponsor has a relationship with a parish can be obtained quite easily. If individual circumstances make it difficult for the chosen sponsor to obtain such a letter, please contact the Faith Formation Office immediately (239.574.2411 or jharrington@standrewrcc.org) to discuss the situation.
