

### Second Sunday of Easter

Acts 5:12-16

#### Christ's Offer of Life and Healing

If you kept a good Lent this year, you have experienced death and rebirth in your spiritual life. If you celebrated the sacrament of reconciliation before Easter this year, you have acknowledged your sin and experienced forgiveness. You have been healed.

One of the first signs of the resurrection was healing. After Jesus rose from the dead, his apostles inherited many of his gifts. They preached powerful sermons. They forgave sins. They healed the sick. People placed the sick on the streets so that Peter's shadow would fall on them as he walked by. Faith was strong. God's Spirit was stronger.

Now that this year's Easter has come, the healing power of God's Holy Spirit will be at work within you. At the Easter Vigil you renewed your baptismal promises. You recommitted yourself to Christ. Now in the Easter season, Christ will recommit himself to you. You bask for fifty days in the glow of glory.

Perhaps you have experienced doubt. Perhaps you wondered if the old you can become a new you. On Ash Wednesday you admitted the sickness of your sin and sought the medicine of Lent. Perhaps now you wonder if the new you will stick. Or will it relapse?

The full grace of this season is yours to receive. The risen Christ stands in glory above the tomb. He offers new life and healing.

### The Chaplet of Mercy

Prayer is essential to our Christian walk. When you pray, it is good to speak from the heart, pouring out your soul to God. But prayer must also follow your faith and all you know of God. It must reflect your true knowledge of God and call upon His Mercy. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is one such prayer that perfectly reflects your faith in the Mercy of God. (See Diary #475-476).



Do you pray? Do you pray every day? Is your prayer centered in faith and truth, enabling you to continually call on the Mercy of God? If you do not pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, try it every day for a week. Be faithful and trust in the faith revealed in the words spoken. You will see the doors of God's Mercy open if you commit yourself to this prayer.

*Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have Mercy on us and on the whole world. Jesus, I trust in You.*

## FR. VOGEL'S COLUMN

Dear Friends in Christ,

Divine Mercy is here! My friends, do not, I repeat, do not let this Sunday pass by as just another regular Sunday for you. Why? Because this Sunday is the only day in the entire year that we can make our time in Purgatory go to zero. This Sunday gives us the opportunity to receive this special grace, as long as we fulfill the appropriate conditions.

What a weekend we have because it's Divine Mercy Sunday weekend. If one were to take advantage of the special graces that are available to us only on Divine Mercy Sunday, and if you were to unfortunately die soon afterwards, you would skip over Purgatory and go straight to Heaven.

How can I receive these special graces on Divine Mercy Sunday? Below are the conditions:

- (1) To receive special graces that our Lord promised for Divine Mercy Sunday, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good Confession beforehand and staying in the state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy.
- (2) The special graces promised by our Lord for Divine Mercy Sunday can be received by a soul in a state of grace, but with imperfect love for God, and imperfect contrition for sin-as long as the soul merely trusts in the mercy of God, and clings to Him because of His promised benefits.
- (3) The special graces that our Lord promised for Mercy Sunday can only be received for oneself, through the devout reception of Holy Communion on Mercy Sunday (as stated in #1 above).
- (4) The most special grace promised by our Lord for Mercy Sunday is nothing less than the equivalent of a complete renewal of baptismal grace in the soul: "complete forgiveness (remission) of sins and punishment."

My friends, this is an exceptional weekend. See the immense amount of Mercy our Lord Jesus Christ is making available to us. Don't miss out on this incredible opportunity. It's why we are making Confessions available at St. Patrick parish in Holden this Sunday at 3:00pm after we sing the Divine Mercy Chaplet (with a guest priest to help hear Confessions) while in Adoration, followed by Mass at 7:00pm (which fulfills your weekend Mass obligation too).

Come to our Lord Jesus so that He can give you His Mercy on this one unique opportunity out of the whole year.



### Catechism of the Catholic Church
