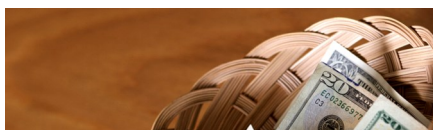

Acts 10:34a, 37-43 Ps 118:1-2, 16-17, 22-23 Col 3:1-4 or 1 Cor 5:6b-8 Jn 20:1-9 or Mk 16:1-7

On this day of days we offer a joyful sacrifice of praise to the Father who raised his Son from the dead. Let us be intent upon the life Christ offers us, Christ our Passover who has been sacrificed.

MONDAY:

Acts 2:14, 22-23 Ps 16:1-2a, 7-11 Mt 28:8-15

Not undergoing corruption, but raised from death, Jesus instructs the women to announce his resurrection to the disciples.

TUESDAY:

Acts 2:36-41 Ps 33:4-5, 18-20, 22 Jn 20:11-18

Mary Magdalene proclaims the resurrection of Jesus, delivered from death, and made both Lord and Messiah.

WEDNESDAY:

Acts 3:1-10 Ps 105:1-4, 6-9 Lk 24:13-35

Invoking the name of Jesus, Peter heals the cripple. The disciples recognize Jesus in the breaking of bread.

THURSDAY:

Acts 3:11-26 Ps 8:2a, 5-9 Lk 24:35-48

Glorified by the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, Jesus is the fulfillment of the Law and the prophets. All things have been put under his power.

FRIDAY:

Acts 4:1-12 Ps 118:1-2, 4, 22-27a Jn 21:1-14

His personal experience of the Risen One leads Peter to proclaim salvation in the name of Jesus of Nazareth, the "stone rejected by the builders".

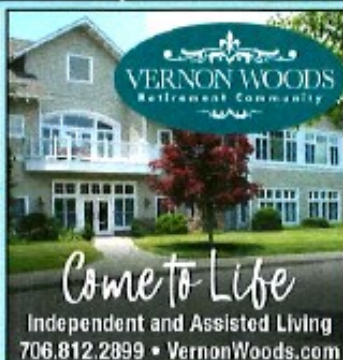
